## Community Grant for Sport in Norwich and Broadland

A new grant to support community sports clubs based in either Norwich or Broadland has been launched and is accepting applications on an on-going basis.

Clubmarked clubs may apply for up to £1,000 whilst clubs or groups without clubmark can apply for up to £500. Funding can be spent on additional equipment, coaching costs and venue hire.
