## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, New Mills Yard footpath) (Emergency Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to safety concerns on the bridge the use by the public of the New Mills Yard footway from its junction with The Moorings for 25m south westwards in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 27<sup>th</sup> March to 16<sup>th</sup> April 2024 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 21 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 6 months.


Alternative route is via: South route - Riverside Walk 16, The Moorings, Coslany Street, Coslany Square, Westwick Street and New Mills Yard. North route - Westwick Street, Barn Road and The Moorings.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
