## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Christchurch Road) (Emergency Continuation Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Notice (CTRO)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst main repairs the use by vehicles of the Christchurch Road from its junction with The Plantation for 50m south-eastwards in the CITY OF NORWICH will continue to be temporarily prohibited from 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2024 (previously 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 3 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

Alternative route is via: Christchurch Road, Unthank Road, Mile End Road, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
