

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (CTRO929) affecting the Colegate from its junction with Duke Street for 20m eastwards in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate emergency electrical fault repairs.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 12th April 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 19th to 22nd April 2024 (previously 12th to 18th April 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 4 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Colegate, Magdalen Street, Magpie Road, Edward Street, New Botolph Street, Pitt Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Westwick Street, Charing Cross, Duke Street.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
