Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Farrow Road) (Urgent Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to carriageway surfacing works the use by vehicles of the Farrow Road from its junction with Earlham Road to its junction with Bowthorpe Road northbound only in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 23rd to 26th April 2024 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 4 days within the period. If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 5 days.


Alternative route is via: Earlham Road, Unthank Road, Grapes Hill and Dereham Road.
