TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2024 (NORWICH)
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

ONLEY STREET - from 55m southeast of its junction with Durham Street for 50m south-eastwards to facilitate electrical link box replacement works from 7th to 10th October 2024 (may continue until the 21st November 2024). Alternative route is via: Onley Street, Leicester Street, Gloucester Street, Unthank Road and vice versa.

SPENCER STREET AND MALBOROUGH ROAD - 1) Spencer Street from 30m south of its junction with Marlborough Road for 30m southwards and; **2) Marlborough Road** from 30m west of its junction with Spencer Road for 30m eastward to facilitate electrical apparatus replacement works from 08:00 on 10th October to 17:00 on 15th October 2024 (may continue until the 26th November 2024). Alternative route is via: 1) Bull Close Road, Magdalen Road, Sprowston Road and Brandford Road; and 2) Magdalen Road, Sprowston Road, Branford Road and Silver Road.

ST ANDREWS HILL - from its junction with St Andrews Street to its junction with Bedford Street to facilitate UK Power Networks electrical connection work between 19:00 and 06:00 from 10th to 14th October 2024 (may continue until 25th November 2024). Alternative route is via: St Andrews Hill, Bedford Street, Gaol Hill, St Giles Street, Chapel Field Road, Grapes Hill, Cleveland Road, Barn Road, St Crispins Road, Duke Street, St Andrews Street.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

GALLEY HILL – 1) Galley Hill from its junction with Drayton Road for 50m eastwards and **2) Whiffler Road** from its junction with Drayton Road for 50m north-eastwards to facilitate Cadent Gas main gas replacement works from 30th September to 25th October 2024 (may continue until the 25th April 2025). Alternative route is via: 1) Galley Hill, Bowers Avenue, Bignold Road, Drayton Road and; 2) Drayton Road, Boundary Road.

RED COTTAGE CLOSE FOOTPATH - from its junction with Red Cottage Close to its junction with Drayton Road to facilitate Cadent Gas main gas replacement works from 30th September to 25th October 2024 (may continue until the 29th March 2025). **N.B the alternative route will be sign posted on site where possible.**

WINCHCOMB ROAD - 1) Winchcomb Road onto Guardian Road and **2) Briar Court** onto Guardian Road to facilitate BT underground works. The Roads 1 and 2 will be temporarily subject to a no right turn restriction between 21:00 and 06:00 from 2nd to 4th October 2024 (may continue until 15th November 2024). Alternative route is via: 1) Guardian Road, Farrow Road, Earlham Road Roundabout, Farrow Road and Guardian Road; 2) Guardian Road, Dereham Road Roundabout and Guardian Road.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s)/ footpath(s). In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Where an Order is for a reason other than works it is because of the likelihood of danger to the public or of serious damage to the road/footpath. **Anticipated dates are stated but the**

Orders may continue until the end date where necessary or required. The Orders are revoked on the end date or on the actual date of removal of the prohibition/restriction where earlier without further notice. If necessary, the restrictions can have a maximum duration of 18 months for vehicular highway or 6 months for non-vehicular highway.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
