Norfolk County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1206) affecting the A) Waterloo Road from its junction with Buxton Road to its junction with Angel Road (the "Road A") and B) Angel Road from its junction with Waterloo Road to its junction with Eade Rode (the "Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate resurfacing works. The Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 19th March 2025 that the Road A and Road B will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be on 24th March 2025 (previously 19th to 23rd March 2025), but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 5th May 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Waterloo Road, Magpie Road, Botolph Street, Edward Street, St Augustines Street, Aylsham Road, Woodcock Road, Angel Road. Southbound - Angel Road, Woodcock Road, Aylsham Road, and Waterloo Road.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road A and Road B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 5th May 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the first Notice was effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
