Norfolk County Council (Norwich) Emergency Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich (CTRO1270) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to electrical repair works the use by of the Netherwood Green Footpath From East Side Of 74 To East Side Of 81 from its junction with Netherwood Green to its junction with Netherwood Green Footpath from Rear of 99 to West Side of 50 (the "Footpath") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Netherwood Green Footpath From Rear Of 99 To West Side Of 50, Netherwood Green Footpath From North Side Of 92 To West Side Of 98, Netherwood Green and vice versa.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the footpath or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 28th May to 4th June 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 17th June 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17th June 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 6 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: UK Power Networks.


A person who contravenes, or who uses the Footpath in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
