

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1257) affecting the A140 Sweet Briar Road from its junction with Drayton Road to its junction with Hellesdon Hall Road ("Road A") and A1074 Dereham Road from its junction with Sweet Briar Road Roundabout to its junction with Old Palace Road ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate Reclamite treatment to carriageway works, the Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) and the Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of the 7.5 tonne weight restriction for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 23:59 on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Road A: A1067 Drayton Road, A1024 Mile Cross Road/ Heigham Street/ Old Palace Road, A1074 Dereham Road, A140 Sweet Briar Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the restriction/closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 27<sup>th</sup> July 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction/closure could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

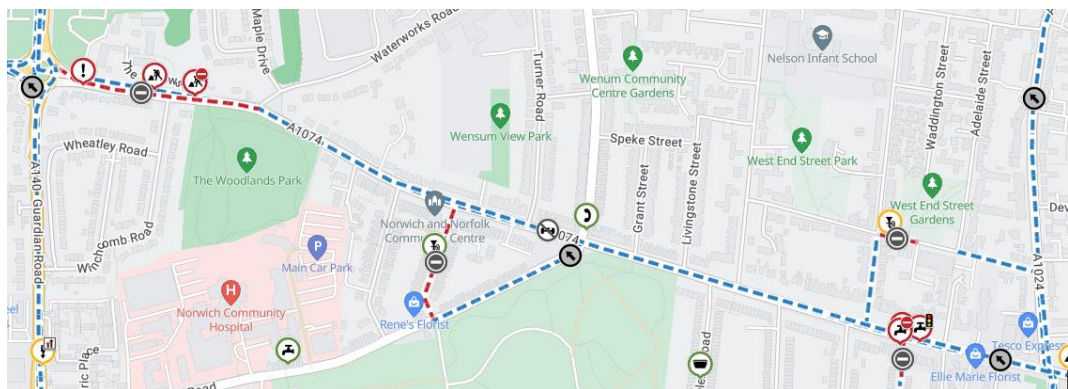
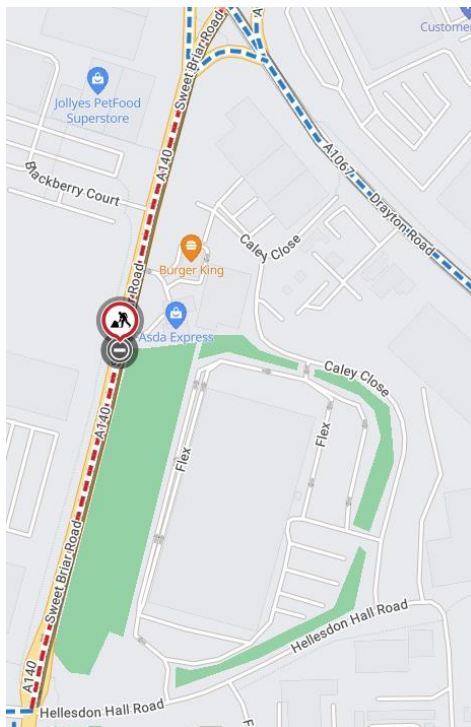
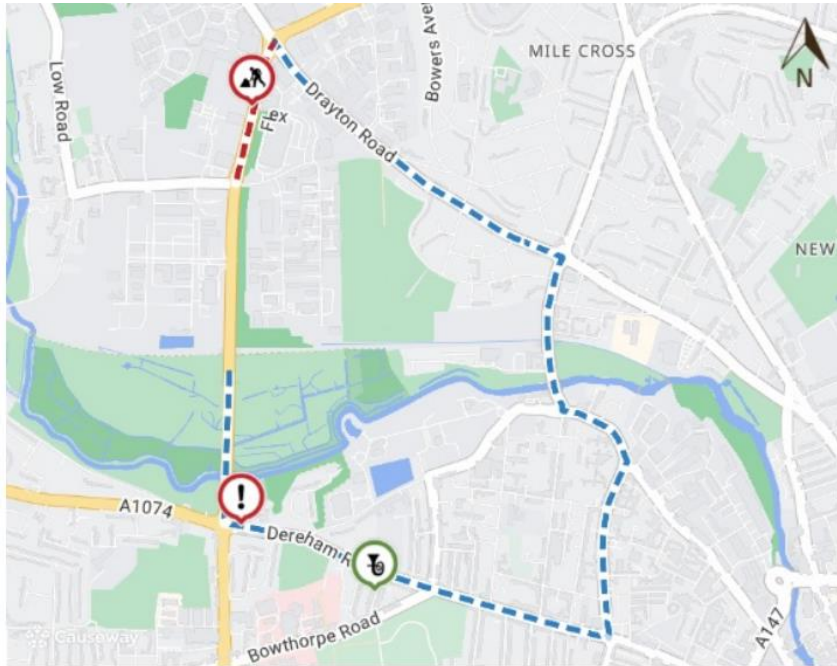
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
