Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1225a) affecting the Quebec Road from its junction with Ketts Hill to its junction with Telegraph Lane ("Road A") and St Leonards Road from its junction with Quebec Road for 50m westwards ("Road B") and St Leonards Road (eastbound lane only) from its junction with Quebec Road for 20m westwards ("Road C") and Wolfe Road from its junction with Quebec Road for 35m eastwards ("Road D") in the City of Norwich to facilitate footway reconstruction works, the Roads A, B and D will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) and Traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) over the Road A, Road C and Road D shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 14th July to 31st August 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 28th February 2026 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route will be displayed by signs on site.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 28th February 2026 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
