

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1258) affecting the Essex Street from 180m east of its junction with Unthank Road to 7m west of its junction with Suffolk Square ("Road A") and Essex Street (westbound lane only) from 220m east of its junction with Unthank Road to 10m west of its junction with Rupert Street ("Road B") and Essex Street from 1m west of its junction with Suffolk Square for 4m westwards ("Road C") in the City of Norwich to facilitate Anglian Water communication pipe replacement works, the Roads A and B shall be temporarily prohibited to park, stop, load, and/or unload and traffic over the Road C shall be prohibited to turn left onto Suffolk Square for the duration of the works/period the restrictions are necessary which is anticipated to be from 21st July to 8th August 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 19th September 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Essex Street, Rupert Street, Vauxhall Street, Walpole Street, Union Street, Norfolk Street, Suffolk Square.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Anglian Water.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A-C where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 19th September 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

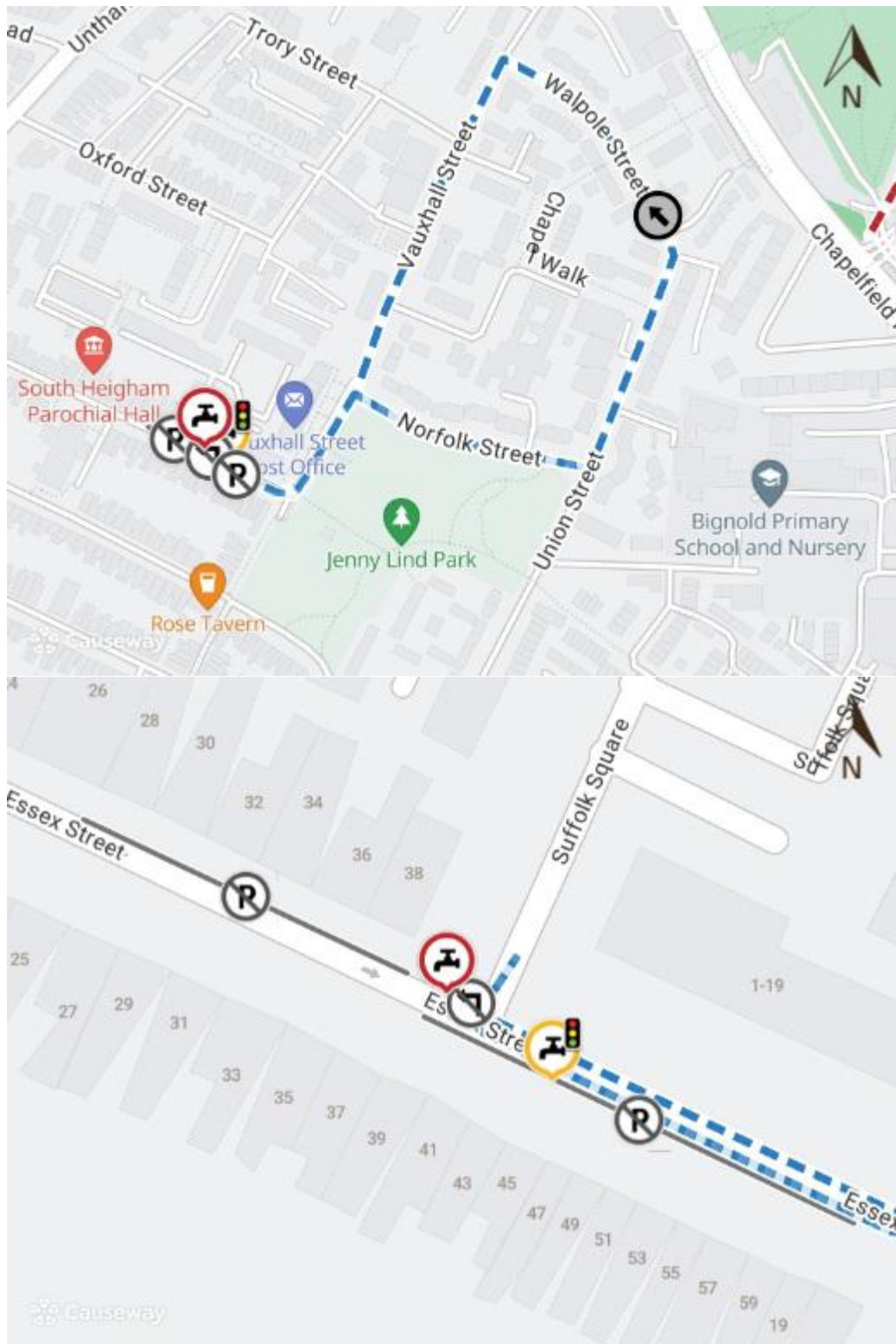
In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
