

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1272) affecting the Pitt Street Cycle Lane from its junction with St Crispins Road for 40m northwards (the "Cycle Lane") in the City of Norwich to facilitate new gas connection works, the Cycle Lane will be temporarily closed/restricted for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 28th July to 1st August 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 8th September 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: N/A – Cyclists will be asked to dismount.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 8th September 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of the Cycle Lane in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

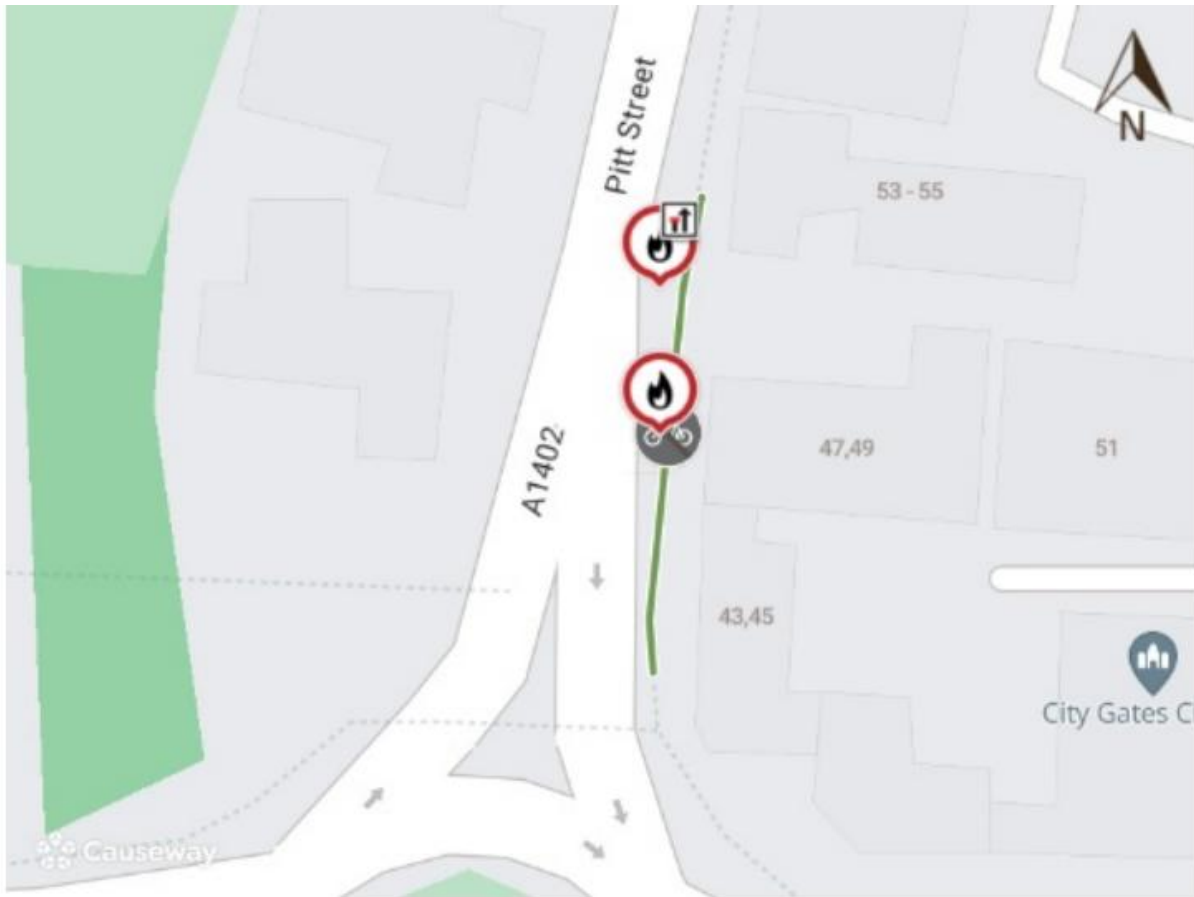
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
