## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Chartwell Road Footway) Urgent Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025

## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Chartwell Road Footway (CTRO1320) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to subsidence of the footway the use of the Chartwell Road Footway from 390m east of its junction with Oak Lane for 20m south eastwards (the "Footway") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: St Clements Hill, Chartwell Road, Mansel Drive, Mile Cross Lane (Norwich, Old Catton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the footway or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place between 09:00 and 16:00 from 28<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July 2025 but the Footway may continue to be closed/restricted until the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 28<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 1<sup>st</sup> August 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Footway in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
