Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1290) affecting the Pitt Street Cycle path from its junction with A147 St Crispins Road to its junction with New Botolph Street (the "Cyclepath") in the City of Norwich to facilitate new electrical connection works. The Cyclepath will be temporarily closed/restricted for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 18th to 20th August 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 1st October 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Cyclists will be asked to dismount and use footway on opposite side of carriageway.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: UK Power Network.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 1st October 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Cyclepath in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
