## The City Council of Norwich (Residents Car Parks) (Cavalry Ride) Amendment 2025

The Norfolk County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 32 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and with the consent of the Norfolk County Council in accordance with section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby make the following order:

- This Order may be cited as The City Council of Norwich (Residents Car Parks) (Cavalry Ride) Amendment 2025 and shall come into operation for all purposes on the XX day of XXX 2025.
- 2. The City of Norwich (Residents Car Parks) Order 1996 as amended (the "1996 Order) is further amended as specified in Articles 3 and 4.
- 3. The provisions of the Schedule to this Order are added to phase 3 of the Schedule of the 1996 Order within the section titled 'Former General Improvement Area car parks managed by Housing Services'
- 4. The plan annexed to this Order marked 'Cavalry Ride car park' shall be annexed to the 1996 Order
- 5. In so far as any provision of this Order conflicts with any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedules to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
