

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1316) affecting the Castle Meadow from 2m west of its junction with Opie Street for 295m southwards ("Road A") and St Stephens Street at its junction with Surrey Street ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate resurfacing works, the Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) and Road B shall be temporarily subject to the suspension of a no right turn restriction allowing traffic (constituting any class of vehicle) to turn right onto Surrey Street for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 31st August to 4th September 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 16th October 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: These works will be carried out in 4 phases. Phase 1 will be between 05:30 on 31st August and 05:30 on 1st September. Phase 2 will be between 19:00 on 1st September and 05:30 on 2nd September. Phase 3 will be between 19:00 on 2nd September and 05:30 on 3rd September. Phase 4 will be between 19:00 on 3rd September and 05:30 on 4th September.

Alternative route is via: St Stephens Street, Surrey Street, All Saints Green, All Saints Street, Golden Ball Street, Cattle Market Street, Market Avenue.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 16th October 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.

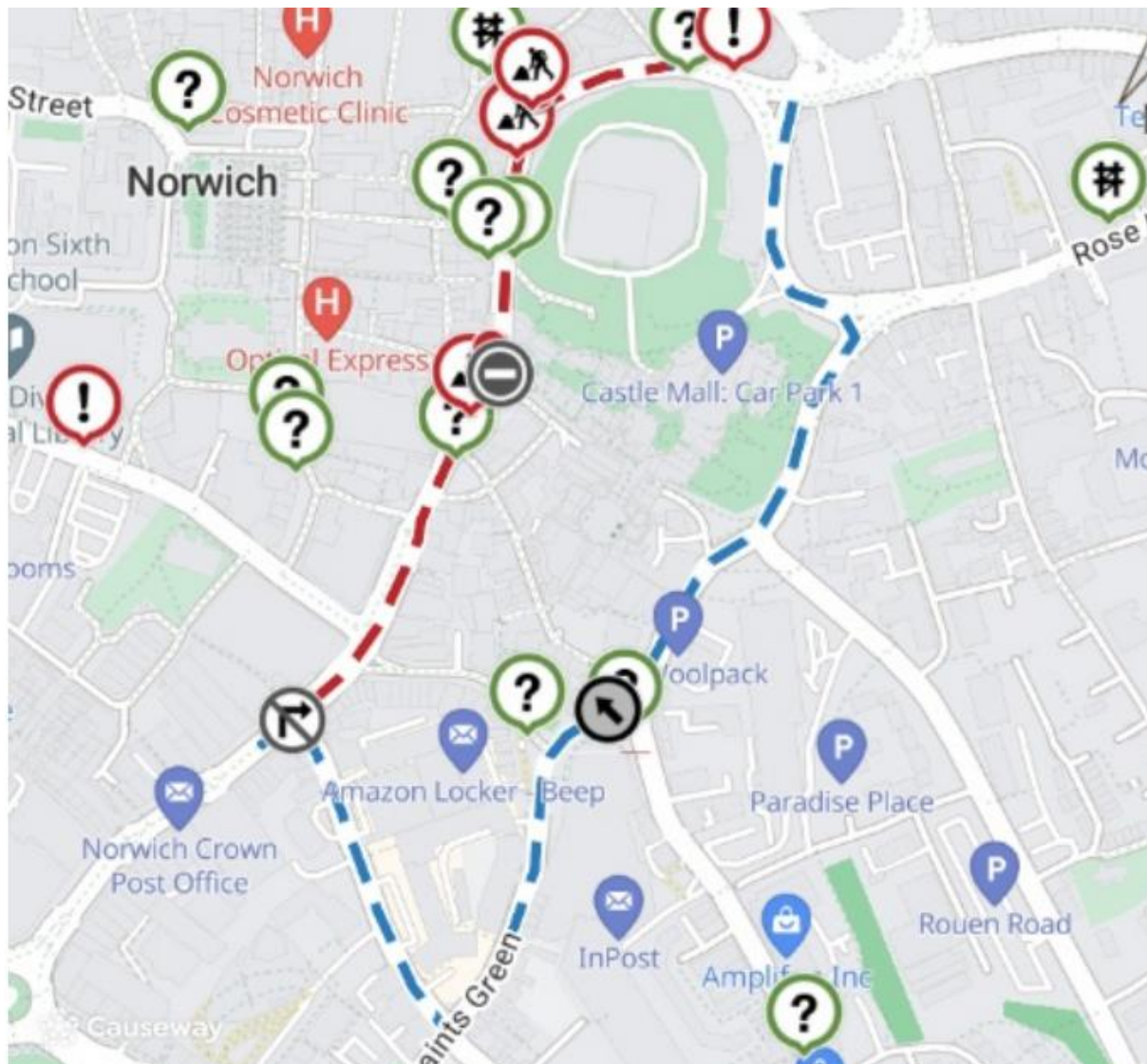
