Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1302) affecting the Eaton Road from 1m south of its junction with Newmarket Road to 135m west of its junction with Waverley Road ("Road A") and Leopold Road from 1m north of its junction with Newmarket Road to 3m south of its junction with Belvedere Place ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate gas main upgrade works, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 22<sup>nd</sup> September to 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Road A: Newmarket Road, Daniels Road, Ipswich Road, Eaton Road and vice versa; Road B: Leopold Road, Melrose Road, Mile End Road, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
