Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1363a) affecting the Prince of Wales Road Cycle Lane from 90m east of its junction with King Street for 25m eastwards (the "Cycle Lane") in the City of Norwich to facilitate gas connection works. The Cycle Lane will be temporarily closed/restricted for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 28th to 30th October 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 11th December 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: this closure/restriction applies to the segregated cycle lane on the south side of the carriageway.

Alternative route is via: N/A: Cyclists will be asked to dismount.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 11th December 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 6 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses the Cycle Lane in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
