Urgent Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Brunswick Road (CTRO1400) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to urgent subsidence investigation and repair works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Brunswick Road from its junction with Thomas Wyatt Close to its junction with Hanover Close (the "Road") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: Northwest bound route – Brunswick Road, Newmarket Road, St Stephens Road, St Stephens Roundabout, Chapel Field Road, Vauxhall Street, Walpole Street, Union Street

Southeast bound route - Brunswick Road, Union Street, Walpole Road, Vauxhall Street, Chapel Field Road, Chapel Field Road/Grapes Hill Roundabout, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Street/Chapel Field Road roundabout, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road and Brunswick Road.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 12th to 14th November 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 16th November 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 12th November to 16th November 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 16th November 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

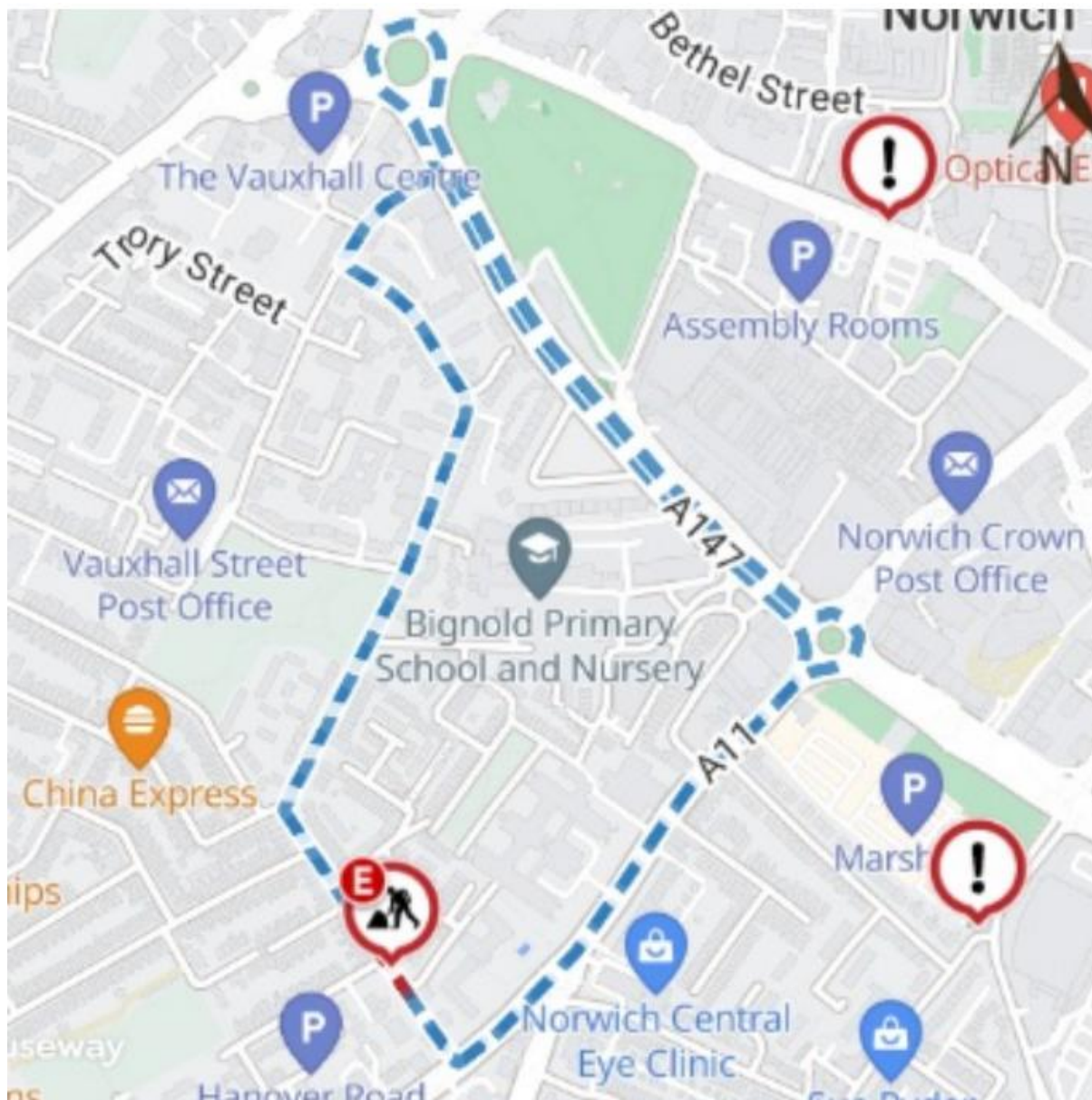
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
