Conservation Area 9 : Earlham

Mid 19C detached house. 2-storeys, white brick. Slate roof. Façade has 2 square bays extending to gables. Right hand bay is larger and taller than left hand bay. Front hand entrance between bays with new porch. Thick glazing bars to windows. Single 2 storey red brick bay and gable at rear. Later single storey lean-to extension at rear. Bargeboards.

<u>**1 & 2 The Gardens</u>** Mid 19C. Pair 2-storey semi-detached cottages. Red brick and tile. Façade has central gable with windows. Modern lean-to brick entrance porches at side of buildings. Casement windows. Continuous brick moulding at eaves and gables. No.2 has good case iron railings over low flint and brick wall continues with railings and gates to Earlham Park. Pair of detached red brick and tile previous wash-houses with chimneys to rear.</u>
