Conservation Area 4: Heigham Grove

Ampthill Street

C19. 2 storeys white brick. Hipped concrete tiled roof. Double-fronted. Central entrance with rectangular fanlight and timber surround. 4 widows to Woburn Street. 12 pane sashes throughout.

5 & 7

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Hipped slate roof. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with rectangular fanlight. 12 pane sashes throughout. Entrance to No 5 on Woburn Street.

9-19 (odd) Coldstream Terrace C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Hipped slate roof to 13, 17, 19; concrete tiled roof to 9, 11, 15. Single-fronted. 9-15: paired entrance doors with rectangular fanlight and timber surround. Remainder simple entrances with rectangular fanlight. Sash windows throughout except for 15, 17, 19 which have been replaced.

21-31 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Hipped slate roof. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 23, 25, 29 replacement windows, remainder 2 pane sashes. 31 returns to Kimberley Street.

4, 6 Cadogan Place, 1833

C19. 2 storeys semi-detached white brick. Hipped slate roof. Single-fronted. Entrance with rectangular fanlight and timber surround. 6 returns to Woburn Street.

8 Avila House

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Slate roof. Double-fronted. Central entrance with semicircular fanlight. 12 pane sashes.

12 & 14

C19. 2 storeys white brick. Paired front doors, 12 lost surround. Concrete tiled roofs. Replacement windows.

20-30 (even)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Slate roof to 20 and 22; concrete tiled roof to 24-30. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with rectangular or semi-circular fanlight to 28 and 30. 20-26 paired front doors with blind window above. Sashes throughout except 26 on 1st floor.

Bathurst Road

1-5 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Hipped slate roof. Single-fronted with recessed entrance. Decorated cornice. Tripartite sash window to ground floor. Stucco and brick surround.

7-15 (odd)

C19. 3 storey, red brick, slate roof. Single-fronted, 3 storey pitched roof of square bay with timber gable. Paired, recessed entrance doors in decorated brick surrounds. Sash windows.

24-32 (even)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Slate roof. Single-fronted, 1-storey splayed bay. Dog-tooth brick cornice. Simple arch, recessed entrance with rectangular fanlight. 26-24 paired entrance. Decorative brickwork. Sash windows. 30 and 32 replacement windows.

34

C19. 2 storeys white brick. Slate roof. Single-fronted. Detached. 1 storey splayed bay. Decorated cornice. Recessed entrance with semi-circular stucco surround and keystone. Sash windows.

4

C19. 2 storeys and attic. Red brick. Slate roof with crested ridge. Double-fronted. 3 storey square bay to include attic. Single storey splayed bay to entrance door. Dog-tooth decorative brickwork at eaves and string course. Barge board at dormer. Brick detail to chimneys.

6-10 (even)

C19. 2 storeys and attic. Red brick. 10 painted brickwork. Slate roof with dormer windows. Single storey splayed bay. 6 has stucco surround to bay. Stucco surround to entrance doors with triangular pediment. 6 and 8 paired entrances. Sash windows except No 10. Brick detail around first floor windows.

Cambridge Street

Importance: Houses along the street have many common original features and seen together, many within continuous terraces, have shared group value. Of particular note is the use of moulded brick for decoration, particularly at eaves level.

3-37 (odd)

C19 terrace houses (gap between 19/21 and 33/35). 3, 5 & 7 are 3 storey with basement and have 4 storey bay windows (cutting through eaves on 5 & 7), 9, 13, 17, 21, 25, 29 are two storey with basement and have two storey square bays; 11, 15, 19, 23, 27, 31, 35 & 37 are 2 storey with basement and have double storey splayed bays: 33 has no bay, but paired windows. White brick. Slate. Linear shared stacks. Decorative moulded brick to eaves and panels between ground and first floor windows. Sash windows (all original except 37) with unusual curved corners to upper glazing, and segmental brick flat arch with curved corners. Proiecting brick architrave doors entablature. 3 has an unusual attic roof form in a 'french chateau' style with dormer window. 5 & 7 have original cast iron railings to front.

41/43

C19 2 storey terrace houses. White brick. Smut Pantiles. Moulded bricks for eaves. Side stacks. Round segmental arch to doors with semi-circular fanlight. Sash windows. Gauged brickwork for lintels (painted on 41).

45

Detached House. 2 story double fronted with two storey bay windows, right hand bays splayed, left hand bays square. Plain red tiles. Side stacks. Stone surrounds to windows and door with decoration. Door has side shafts with rosette detailing and swags cornice with grotesque faces and large central keystone. Brickwork tile panel between ground and first floor.

49-63 (odd)

(53/55 'Pentrell Villas'; 57/59 'Oak Villas'). C19 Terrace. Single storey bay window to 49, 51, 53, 55. White brick. Smut Pantiles (61 replacement cement tiles). Side stacks slightly of edge. Moulded brickwork to eaves. Red brick gauged brickwork lintels (Only 53 & 57 retain original sash windows.)

65-75 (odd)

Terrace houses. White brick. Red Pantiles. Shared white brick stacks. Sawtooth brick eaves detailing. Red brick gauged brick flat arches (65/67 painted). All windows originally sashes but now replaced except 55 that is missing central glazing bar. 73 has later porch extension.

26-40 (even) "University Terrace"

C19 terrace houses. White brick. Ground floor splayed bay windows with cornice. Projecting brick architrave to front doors with entablature. Smut pantiles. Bracket dentilled brick cornice to eaves. Gauged brick flat arches with brick keystones (36 painted). Shared stacks except ends of terrace. 28/30, 36/38. 40 have original dentilled detailing.

42/44 "Jasmine Villas"

Semi detached houses. White brick. Smut pantiles. Side stacks. Dentilled brick eaves. Gauged brick flat arches. 44 has original sash windows, 42 modern windows.

46, 46a, 48

Terrace houses. White brick. One storey bay with moulded brick cornice, but only 46a remains unaltered and 46 has an uncharacteristic red tile pitch over bay and door. Replacement tiles. Side stacks, missing on 48. Sawtooth eaves. Sash windows (46 replacement).

50/52

Semi detached pair of houses. White brick. 2 storey with 2 storey splayed bay window. Slate. Moulded brick special eaves. Sash windows. windows bordered with Central rusticated architrave with bracketed and egg and dart cornice. Rusticated shaft extension to eaves above. Eaves are bracketed and egg and dart bricks. Rusticated brick moulded Decorative brick panels with trefoil pattern between ground and first floors. Original doors and passageway entrance with rectangular fanlights containing original stained glass. Sash windows with unusual triangulated containing a motif and triangulated gauged brick lintels.

62/64

Pair of houses within terrace. White brick 2 storey with 2 storey bay window. Slate roof. 62 stunted stack, 64 missing. Decorative circular stone architraves to recessed porches and passageway door, with decorative keystone and springing points (flowers, grotesques). Moulded stone lintels with recessed panels and keystone.

66-72 (even)

Terrace houses. White brick. Smut pantiles. Side stacks (66 replaced with later red brick stack). Gauged brickwork lintels. Circular lintel to doors. Only 70 has original sash windows. 68 much altered.

74/76

pair of houses within terrace. White brick. Smut pantiles. 74 has side stack, 76 ridge stack. Gauged brickwork lintels with circular lintels to entrances (74 painted). Sash windows.

78/80/82

Terrace houses. White brick. Red pantiles. Side stacks (80/82 combined). Moulded brickwork to eaves. Stone lintels with keystone. 80 has original sash windows. 78 & 82 replaced. 82 has later porch extension.

Clarendon Road

2-8 (even)

C19. 2-6, 2 storeys and attic. 8, 2 storeys. Red brick. Slate roof with crested ridge. 2-6, 3 storey square bay to include attic dormers. 8, 2 storey square bay. Dog-tooth eaves, string course. Brick portico with rectangular fanlight over door. 4 and 6 paired entrances. Sash windows. Brick boundary wall.

10 & 12

C19. 2 storeys red brick. Plain tiled roof. 10, 2 storey square bay. Dog-tooth eaves, string course. Sash windows. Entrance to side. 12, 2 storey splayed bay. Dog-tooth eaves, string course. Sash windows. Entrance door with rectangular fanlight. Railings between 10 and 12.

14, 16

Late C19. 2 storeys semi-detached white brick. 14, double-fronted; 16, single-fronted. Decorated cornice and string course and 2 storey splayed bay. Simple brick portico. Quoins. Slate roof.

18-22 (even)

Late C19. 2 storeys white brick. Slate roof. Single –fronted. Decorated cornice and string course and 2 storey hipped splayed bay. Decorated brick portico. Quoins. Dormer windows to 20 and 22. Replacement windows to 22, remainder sashes.

46-74 (even)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Mixture of slate and concrete tiles to roof. Single –fronted, 1 storey splayed bay. Decorate cornice, bay and entrance. Paired entrances. Rectangular fanlight. 72: third storey gable with lead roof and enclosing a venetian window. Long and short quoins. Sash windows throughout except to 48, 60 and 66.

3-17 (odd) Clarendon Terrace C19. 3 storeys terrace red brick. Slate and concrete tiled roof. Single –fronted. Recessed entrance with semi-circular arches. Mainly sash windows throughout.

19-33 (odd) Claremont Terrace 1879 C19. 2 storey red brick, slate roof, single-fronted, paired entrance doors to 27/29 and 31/33. All entrances have stucco surrounds and canopies with console brackets. Single storey splayed bays to 19-25 and No 29. Later 19th Century brick single storey square bays to No 27, 31 and 33. Sash windows, replaced to Nos. 31 and 33. Original railings and gate to No. 33.

35, 37 Holland Terrace C19. 2 storeys terrace with basement and attic, white brick. Slate roof with dormers. Single-fronted. Ground floor sash with decorative moulded surround. Raised paired entrance with rectangular fanlight. Railings.

39-49 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys with attic, white brick. Slate roof. Timber gabled dormers. Single-fronted, 1 storey splayed bay. Decorated cornice, bay and entrance. Paired entrance with rectangular fanlight. Sash windows. 43, replacements to 1st floor. 49, 2 storey splayed bay with modern flat roof dormer.

Doris Road

Earlham Road

Synagogue

1969 by Wearing Hastings and Rossi. White brick. Green zinc Octagonal Roof. Stained glass by Paul Jerreries of local firm G. King and Sons.

Importance: Unique building representing the Jewish faith group in Norwich. The building was designed by local architects and incorporates local craftsmanship

1-6 Francee Court

Flats. Early to mid C20th. Render with red brick detailing. Pantiles. Crittal windows. Large prominent feature stack to front.

Importance: An interesting example of neovernacular interwar development retaining original stylistic features.

The Mitre

Public House. Early to mid C20th public house. Mock Tudor. Overhanging eaves and plain tiles. Importance: A typical interwar suburban style of pub that has become a local landmark.

Early C19. 2 storeys white brick. Slate roof. 4 sashes. Side entrance with simple pilasters.

58

Late C19. 2 storeys, white brick with red brick dressings. Slate roof. Decorated eaves cornice. Splayed 3-light bay to R. Square projection L with 2 sashes. Central sash over entrance with column.

60 & 62

Mid C19. 2 storeys white brick. Hipped slate roof. Long and short quoins. 6 sashes with surrounds. Simple entrances with semi-circular fanlights and surrounds.

66, 68

C19. 2 storeys semi-basement. and semi-detached, white brick. Slate roof. Double-fronted. Triple arched sash windows on ground floor, 3 shallow-arched sash windows on upper floor. Decorated string course. Long and short quoins. Central entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 68, 1 replacement window.

70, 72, 74, 76

C19. 2 storeys, semi-detached, white brick (74 painted brick). Slate roof. Double-fronted, one 1 storey splayed bay with sash windows. Simple central entrance with rectangular fanlight. 3 first floor sash windows, 1 ground floor sash window. Moulded stucco surrounds to windows.

78,80

C19. 2 storeys semi-detached white brick. Slate roof. 78, 2 storey splayed bay. 78, long and short quoins. Simple entrance with rectangular fanlight. 80, single storey splayed bay with sash windows. 78, 3 sash windows to 1st floor, 1 to ground floor, 80, 2 sash windows to 1st floor, entrance door to side.

82-86 (even)	C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Hipped slate roof. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 2 sash windows to 1 st floor, 1 on ground floor.
88,90	C19. 3 storeys semi-detached white brick. Hipped slate roof with dormers. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 88, 2 replacement windows on 1 st floor. Stucco surround to ground floor, tripartite sash windows.
92-98 (even) Eden Villas	C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Slate roof. Single-fronted. 94 painted brick. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 92: 2 storey splayed bays, 3 sash windows. 94 and 96: single storey splayed bays, 2 sashes to first floor. 98 (Havelock House) end of terrace. Replacement windows and doors in original openings.
100-104 (even)	C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. Slate roof. Double-fronted, one 2 storey splayed bay. 104: two 2 storey splayed bays. Long and short quoins. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 104: portico. Sash windows.
106	C19. 2 storeys white brick. Detached. Concrete tiled roof. Double-fronted. Central simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 5 sashes.
108	C19. 2 storeys white brick. Detached. Concrete tiled roof. Double-fronted. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. Replacement windows.
110, 112	C19. 2 storeys semi-detached white brick. Hipped concrete tiled roof. Single-fronted. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight. 3 sash windows.

43-55 & 57, 57a (odd)

Late C19 (date 1896). Architect C S Beck. 2 storeys, white brick. Slate roof. Terrace of shops with many original features. No 57, corner turret with spire. 3 sashes. Entrance on splayed corner with sash above. Later shop fronts.

59-71 (odd) Earlham Road Terrace 1853 C19. 2½ storeys and semi-basement. White brick. 59-67 black glazed pantile roof, 69-71 concrete tiles. Roof lights. Ground floor splayed bays (except 59). 2 sashes per house, some replacement windows. Single-fronted. Quoins. Simple entrance with semi-circular fanlight.

79

C19. 2 storeys white brick painted and rendered. Double-fronted. Slate roof. 2 storey gabled square bay. Central entrance with projecting porch, balcony over. Sash windows throughout.

81-87 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys terrace white brick. 81, 85, 87 hipped slate roof, 83, concrete tiles. Double-fronted. 83: painted brick. Long and short quoins. Central entrance with rectangular fanlight and stucco surround. 5 sash windows with moulded stucco surrounds. 87 Waldeck House.

93 & 95

C19. 2 storeys red brick. Slate roof. Double-fronted 2 storey splayed bay. Central simple entrance with porch. 93, replacement windows in original openings.

97-123 (odd) Curfew Terrace Late C19. 3 storeys terrace red brick. Plain tiled roof. Single-fronted. 3 pairs of 'Dutch' gables of different shapes, with 1 storey rectangular bays below; alternating with pairs of dormers, with 1 storey splayed bays below with curved lead roof. Decorative brick cornice and string course. Recessed entrances with rectangular fanlight. Generally sash windows throughout.

125, 127

C19. 2 storeys semi-detached red brick. Hipped slate roof. Original sashes. Entrance at side of main frontage.

Essex Street

Importance: Terrace houses and semi detached houses retain many original features. Seen together they have shared group value.

C19. Detached double fronted 2 storey house. White brick (red brick to sides and rear). Slate roof. Slightly off centre stack and side stack. Sash windows. Gauged brick flat arches. Feature central window surround to first floor with bracketed flat canopy. Gauged brick circular arch above door with segmental circular fanlight.

3

C19 'Hanover House' Detached 2 storey double fronted house. White brick (red brick to sides and rear). Slate roof. Side stacks. Sash windows. Guged brick flat arches. Circular arch to door with circular fanlight.

5/7 'Highbury Villas' 9/11'Essex Villas' 13/15

C19 semi detached houses. White brick (No 5 painted). Sash windows. Slate roof. Central shared stack. Timber door surrounds with flat canopies and decorative scrolled brackets. (NB: Same design as 15-21 Trinity Street).

17 Rectory for Holy Trinity Church

2 storey with basement. White brick. Slate roof and large stack with projecting cornices. Heavy dentilled red brick cornice at eaves and a decorative tiled string course. Paired sash windows with large panes and stone lintels (first floor lintels in line with cornice have stone brackets).

Importance: Characteristic Victorian Rectory designed with many decorative architectural features.

Wall to Rectory and Church

C19 wall built of flints, white brick courses with stone coping and ironwork to ridge.

Importance: Contemporary with Church and Rectory and therefore of group value. (See also Trinity Street.)

19-29 (odd).

C19. 2 storey semi detached houses. White brick. Slate roof (19, 23 replacement tiles). Central stack (missing on 25). Sash windows (replaced 29). Gauged flat brick arches (painted 19, 25, 29). Shared architrave to doors with entablature. Blind window above.

2 & 4 "Devonshire Villas".

C19. 2 storey semi detached houses. White brick Slate roof. Shared linear stack. Sash windows. Gauged brick flat arches. Timber architrave to doors with fanlight.

6 & 8 "York Villas".

C19. 2 storey semi detached houses. White brick. Slate roofs. Shared linear stack. Gauged brick flat arches. Doors have double segmental gauged brick arches. Sash windows.

10 & 12. "Trinity Place"

C19. 2 storey double fronted pair of houses within terrace. White brick. Slate roofs. Stacks removed. Gauged brick flat arches. Segmental gauged brick with recessed inner plaster door surround. Circular fanlight above door. Sash windows.

14 & 16

2 storey pair of houses within terrace. White brick. Slate roofs. Shared linear stack. Replacement windows (originally sashes). Timber architrave to door with fanlights.

South Heigham Parochial Hall

C19 Parish hall; White brick front elevation in pseudo medieval gothic, red brick to sides and rear. Front elevation has gothic stone windows, the centre door has a four centred arch, and all have drip moulds. Central stone rose window is a prominent feature on facade.

Importance: Victorian parish hall with interesting rose window and gothic style moulded brick lettering.

18 & 20

C19. 2 storey semi detached houses. White brick. Door and ground floor windows have unusual projecting rusticated projecting brick surrounds to door and ground floor windows. Wall band. Sash windows (replaced on 20).

22-28 (even)

"Belgrave Terrace"

C19. Terrace. 2 storey. White brick. Slate roof. Shared stacks. Sash windows (unusual with three vertical panes). Timber architrave to door with fanlights.

30-40 (even)

C19 white brick terrace houses (30 & 36 painted). Slate roof. Sash windows (Replaced 30 & 36). Paired architraves (38 and 40 individual) with fanlights. Blind window above.

Grosvenor Road

5-11 (odd) (with 33 Unthank Road)

C19. 2 storeys and basement and attic. Single-fronted. Slate roof. Concrete to 9, red brick. 3 storey splayed pitched roof bays (incl. basement). Front doors in brickwork surround with triangular pediment over. Sash windows except No 5, dormers.

13 and 15

C19. 2 storeys, concrete tiled roof, painted brickwork. Single-fronted, replacement windows. Later lean-to porch to No 13. Semi-circular fanlight and stucco arch with keystone to No 15.

17-23 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys, slate roof, white brick (except 19 rendered, 21 painted). Single-fronted, single storey splayed pitched roof bays to 21 and 23. Semi-circular brick arch and fanlight over entrance door. Sash windows. 19 and 21: replaced.

25-29 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys, concrete tiled roof, white brick. Single-fronted. Semi-circular fanlight and stucco arch with keystone above entrance door. Sash windows. Ground floor sash tri-partite with rounded upper corners.

31-37, 39 & 41 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys, slate roof, red brick, single-fronted. Paired entrance doors under simple brick arch with stucco springing and semi-circular fanlight. Single storey pitched roof splayed bay with decorative stucco bosses at junction of moulded brick window surrounds. Brick eaves cornice.

2-12 (even)

C19. 2 storeys, attic and basement. Red brick. Single-fronted. Slate roof. No 8 concrete tile roof. Dormer windows, gabled dormer to No 2. 3 storey splayed bays to include basement. Decorative triangular pediment over doors. Sash windows. Replacement windows to 12 and part of 2. Brick front wall.

14

C19. 2 storeys. Red brick. Concrete tile roof. Single-fronted. Single storey splayed bay with stucco surround. Entrance with semi-circular arch and decorated keystone. Semi-circular fanlight. Sash windows.

16-26 (even) Hanover Terrace C19. 2 storeys. Red brick. 16: painted brickwork. 20 and 22: part rendered. 16: concrete tile roof, remainder slate. Paired front doors under semi-circular arch with decorated keystone. Semi-circular fanlight. Single storey splayed bay with stucco surround. Sash windows to 18 and 24. Remainder replacements. Brick details at eaves.

28, 30 1884 C19. 2 storey and attic. Red brick. Slate roof with dormers and gabled brick dormers. 28: double-fronted. Three 2 storey splayed bays with parapet roof and decorative iron railing. Decorative stucco detail between ground and first floor on bay. 28: sash windows. 30: replacement. Simple entrance with timber surround and rectangular fanlight. Garage to side of 30.

32-40 (even)

C19. 2 storey and attic. Red brick. Single-fronted. Single storey square bay with parapet roof. Timber and rendered gabled dormer. 34/36, 38/40 paired entrances. Entrances recessed with triangular pediment over front door. Square fanlight. Sash windows. Brick and flint boundary wall with blue bull nose capping stone.

Heigham Grove

1-9 & 9a (consec)

Late Victorian 2 storeys stuccoed. Pantiled roof with moulded eaves cornice. One window each. Double doorcases, some with pediments.

Heigham Road

1-7 (odd)

C19. 2 storeys terrace. White brick. Black glazed pantile roof. 3 sashes per house. 1, 3 and 5 have original sashes, 7 replacement windows. Simple entrances with semi-circular fanlight. 1 has rooflights.

9

C19. 2 storeys red brick. Detached. Sash windows with coloured glass in margins/inserts. Central front door with 2 splayed bays. Hipped slate roof. Square fanlight over door.

11 & 13

C19. 2 storeys, white brick. Semi-detached. Single-fronted. Ground floor splayed bays with timber detail to eaves and bay. 11: bay extended to form porch with pitched roof. Lion head guttering. 13: painted brickwork. Replacement windows to first floor. Panelled door with semi-circular fanlight. Flat roof to bay.

Kimberley Street

1-9 (odd) Duke Terrace C19. 2 storeys terrace, white brick. Slate to 9, remainder concrete tiled roof. Single-fronted. Simple entrances with semi-circular fanlight. Wide central arch over rear accessway. Replacement windows to No 5. No 1 part of Kimberley Arms PH.

11

C19. 2 storeys, white brick. Concrete tiles. Sash windows.

13 & 15

C19. 2 storeys, white brick. Hipped slate roof. 15: double-fronted with replacement windows and doors throughout. Concrete tiles and rendered. Semi-circular fanlight over entrance doors to No 13. Sash windows.

Mill Hill Road

2-10a (even)

Late C19. 3 pairs semi-detached houses. 3 storeys with square bay. White brick. Front door to side of building. 2 has painted brickwork. 2 and 6 clay pantiled roof, remainder slate. Replacement windows to 8, remainder sash windows. Parking in front gardens of 6 and 8. Properties set back and raised up from road.

Former Swedenborg Church 1890. By AF Scott. Red brick with stone detailing. Gothic style windows

Importance: A good example of a late C19 suburban church that has a scale appropriate for the surrounding context. Currently under review for listed building status.

Dormers. Pitched canopies over doors. Casement 'cottage style' windows. 10, 11, 15 and 16: 2 storey gabled features.

Cottages arranged in a semi-crescent layout around a central green/sports ground.

C20. Possibly Boulton & Paul prefabricated building. Single storey. Diamond-shaped asbestos roof tiles. Timbered gables and dormers. Casement windows.
