Conservation Area 10 : Lakenham

Long John Hill

- The Cock PH 19C with extensive 20C additions and alterations. 2-storey pebbledash render on 1st floor. Ground floor – flint with brick dressings. Various later single storey extensions to side and rear of building. Tiled roof. Bargeboards. Late 19C or early 20C casement windows. Verandah on front facing river. Wrought iron guttering brackets 1920s and later.
- The Old Mill Site comprises two buildings:

Viewed from Long John Hill, left hand mill: Early 19C. 3 storeys. Hipped slate roof with lucams. 5 bays, doors on ground floor, sash windows on 1st floor. Tie irons. Painted brickwork.

Right hand mill: Mid 19C. 3 storeys. Hipped slate roof with lucams. Two storeyed timber clad hoist housing inserted into front of building. 4 bays, quoins, long and short revealed brick window surrounds. Random coursed brickwork on Mansfield Road elevation and rear. Tie irons. Painted brickwork.
