



1 Listed urinal: on St Crispins Road you'll find what is said to be the oldest surviving example of a prefabricated concrete urinal in the UK, now a Grade II listed building, dating back to 1919.

2 Wensum Park: opened in 1925 as part of a public works programme to create jobs, it boasts two children's play areas and a paddling pool – as well as a riverside area to feed ducks!



3 Prince of Denmark: at this pub you can gaze up at the impressive relief mural of the Prince of Denmark, produced in 1939 by John Moray-Smith.

4 Iazar House: founded before 1119 by Bishop Herbert de Lozinga as the St Mary Magdalen Leper Hospital, located outside the city walls to minimise the risk of contagion.



5 Norwich Prison: this route takes you past Britannia Barracks, built in 1887 as the home of the Norfolk Regiment and now part of Norwich Prison. Great views across the city from Café Britannia.

6 Rosary Cemetery: founded in 1821 as the UK's first non-denominational cemetery. A real gem as well as a wildlife haven within the city.



7 Dragon Hall: a unique medieval merchant trading hall, dating from around 1430. The King Street building, now home to the Writers' Centre Norwich, stands as a proud reminder of our boast that Norwich is the UK's only UNESCO City of Literature.

Norwich 9km

North-east tour: this 9km ride along the pedalways takes in some of the city's renowned buildings as well as lesser-known sites and features. These range from an early 15th century merchant trading hall to a beautiful cemetery, which also doubles as a wildlife haven within the city. So, let your wheels do the work and enjoy some of the delights that Norwich has to offer.
