ASSESSMENT OF THE EFFECTS OF THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT OF ANGLIA SQUARE ON THE SIGNIFICANCE OF DESIGNATED HERITAGE ASSETS

- 1. In the table below I set out my evaluation of the impact of the proposed redevelopment of Anglia Square on the significance of those designated heritage assets identified by CgMs as being affected.
- 2. The order of the assets follows that established by CgMs.
- 3. This evaluation follows the approach of the National Planning Policy Framework. As set out in my proof, I consider that the harm caused by the proposed development would in all cases be less than substantial, in the language of the Framework. The measures of harm set out here suggest where, in the range of less than substantial harm, the harm identified would lie.
- 4. I have not followed the approach in CgMs's table, which is that of environmental impact assessment.
- 5. With the exception of 43-45 Pitt Street, which would be demolished and thus suffer total loss of significance, I have not included undesignated heritage assets. These are included in CgMs's assessment.
- 6. I have not added to the list of assets affected identified by CgMs. In my proof I have suggested that there would be harm to the significance of some listed buildings beyond those on this list. When doing so I have generally referred to the buildings maps in the Norwich City Centre Conservation Area, which identify listed buildings. I have also suggested that the significance of all the extant medieval churches of the city would be harmed to some degree.
- 7. In all cases which are not included in this table the degree of harm within the range of less than substantial harm would be "some" or "minor", unless otherwise indicated in the proof.
