NOTICE OF AN ARTICLE 4(1) DIRECTION RELATING TO THE CONVERSION OF OFFICES TO RESIDENTIAL

Please take notice that Norwich City Council has confirmed a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 2015 (as amended) which relates to the land shown outlined and hatched in red on the attached Plan.

The effect of this Article 4 Direction will be to prevent development which is the change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class E(g) (i) (an office to carry out any operational or administrative functions) to a use falling within Class C3 of that Schedule (dwellinghouses) unless planning permission is granted by the Council for it. The Article 4 Direction will therefore prevent development comprised within Class MA of Part 3 of Schedule 2 of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended).

The Direction will take effect on 29th July 2022.
