	Overview of recent issues and resolution	
	10 th Sept – Mitie awarded contract Following standstill pre-start meeting was held on 23 rd Sept. A meeting was called to discuss their concerns and issues, whichstem heavily from the current challenges faced by the construction industry.	
	The meeting resulted in a revision to the contract following advise from NPLaw and Eastern Procurement. Mitie agreed the revised scope. Compliant bidders were notified of the scope change and submitted revised prices. The revised prices were reviewed and evaluated by NCC and it was recommended that the contract proceed with Mitie. This was accepted by NCC Corporate Leadership Team and the NCC Cabinet on 13 th Oct 2021. The project is still within budget and still within the original programme, and now due to start on the 3rd November. Proposed necessary works to Old Carrow House are currently under review to determine priorities, and next steps to programme them in.
