

Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Sprowston)
(Emergency Notice)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to carriageway Subsidence the use by vehicles of the A1151 Sprowston Road from its junction with A1042 Mousehold Lane for 50m south-westwards in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 13th to 23rd April 2023 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 11 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

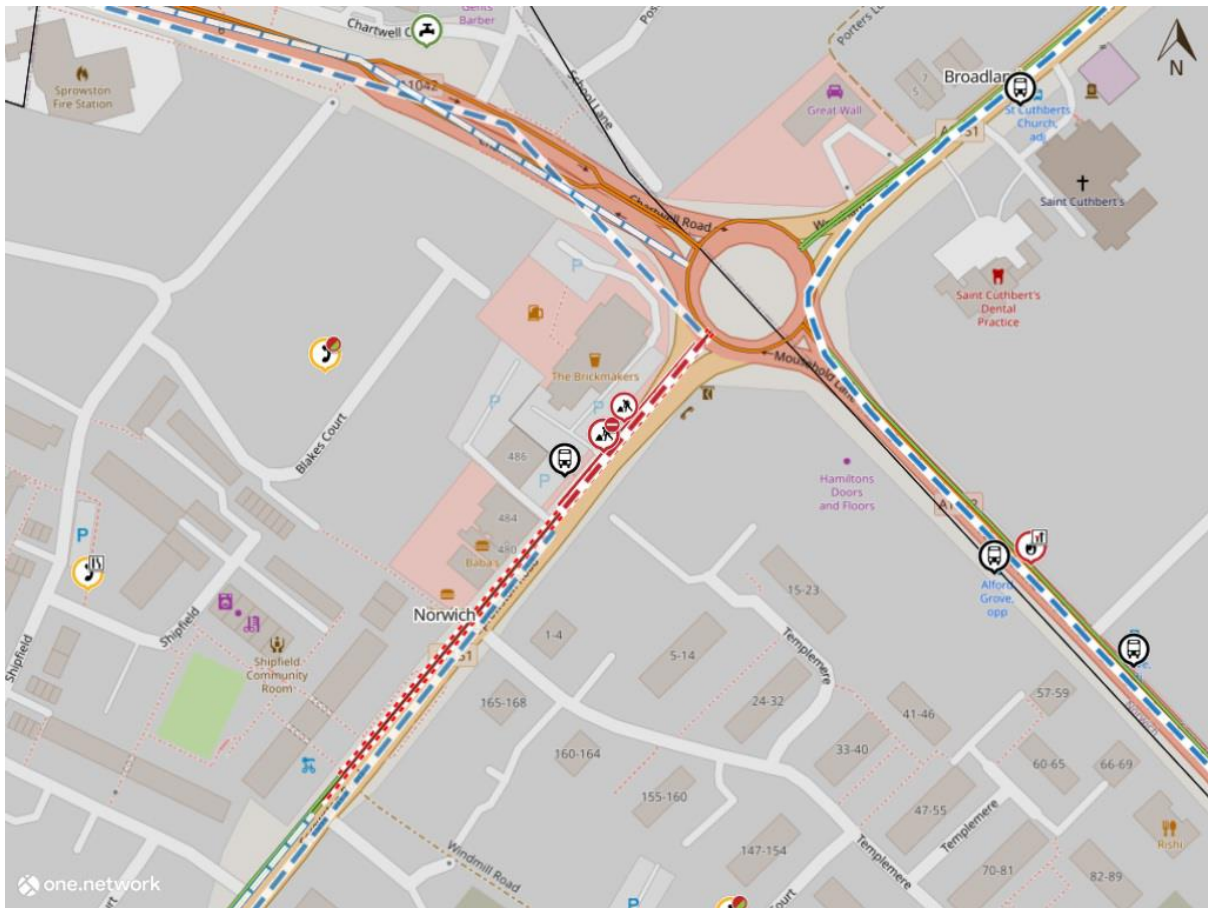

HGV Traffic - A1042 Chartwell Road, Mile Cross Lane, A1402 Aylsham Road, A1067 St Augustins Street, Pitt Street, A147 St Crispins Road Charlton Road A1151, Bull close road A1151, Magdalen Road.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
