## Norfolk County Council TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH CITY) Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) **THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**<u>COWGATE</u>** - from its junction with Bull Close for 30m eastwards to facilitate Anglian water maintenance works from 17<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: Eastbound - Bull Close, Bull Close Road, Charlton Road, Barrack Street/St Crispins Roundabout and Cowgate. Westbound - Cowgate, Charlton Road, Bull Close Road and Bull Close.

**DOGWOOD ROAD** - footpath Norwich 4F23 from its junction with Dogwood Road for its entire length to facilitate telecoms installation works from 15<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: Dogwood Road, Fiddlewood Road Footpath and vice versa.

**MOUSEHOLD LANE** - from its junction with Alford Grove to its junction Moorland Close to facilitate private development highway amendment works. The road will be temporarily subject to a 20mph speed restriction; and traffic using the road will be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles from 18<sup>th</sup> May to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2023. Alternative route is N/A.

(ii) **THEY HAVE MADE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

<u>GLENMORE GARDENS</u> - footpath Norwich 4F623 from its junction with Mile Cross Road to its junction with Glenmore Gardens to facilitate footpath remedial works from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: Glenmore Gardens, Aylsham Road, Mile Cross Road and vice versa.

**HELLESDON ROAD** - footpath Norwich 4F510 from its junction with Hellesdon Road for its entire length to facilitate fibre installation works from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: Hellesdon Road.

<u>ST. AUGUSTINES</u> - 1) St Augustines Street from its junction with Pitt Street to its junction with Sussex Street; 2) Pitt Street from its junction with New Botolph Street to its junction with St Augustines Street; and 3) Botolph Street from its junction with New Botolph Street to its junction with St Augustines Street to facilitate fibre network cable works from 1<sup>st</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Dereham Road, Sweet Briar Road, Boundary Road, Reepham Road, Cromer Road and Aylsham Road. Alternative route for access to Esdelle Street and Catherine Wheel Opening is via - St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Barn Road roundabout, St Crispins Road, Oak Street and Sussex Street.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths and cycle paths.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
