## Norfolk County Council TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH CITY) Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**CARROW ROAD** - from 12m northeast of its junction with King Street for 70m north-eastwards to facilitate bridge maintenance and repair works between 19:00 and 05:00 from 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023; and 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 (back-up dates). Alternative route is via: Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Barrack Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, Queens Road, Bracondale, King Street and vice versa.

**JAMIESON PLACE 3** - footpath Norwich 4F503 from its junction with Jamieson Place to its junction with Knowland Grove to facilitate fibre installation works from 13<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Jamieson Place, Jamieson Place Footpath, Knowland Grove, Jamieson Place Footpath, Knowland Grove and vice versa.

**RUPERT STREET, NORFOLK STREET, ESSEX STREET AND TRINITY STREET - 1) Rupert Street** from its junction with Norfolk Street to its junction with Essex Street (both sides of the carriageway); **2) Norfolk Street** from 15m east of its junction with Rupert Street for 30m eastwards (south side of the carriageway only); **3) Essex Street** from its junction with Rupert Street to its junction with Suffolk Square (both sides of the carriageway); and **4) Norwich 4Y79 footpath/cycle path** from its junction with Trinity Street to its junction with Rupert Street to facilitate footway resurfacing scheme works. The roads 1), 2) and 3) will be subject to a temporary parking restriction and vehicles will not be permitted to stop, load or unload; and the footpath 4) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 12<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Alternative route is via: 1), 2) and 3) N/A; and 4) Rupert Street, Norfolk Street, Union Street, Cambridge Street, Trinity Street and vice versa.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following road:

**CARROW ROAD** - from its junction with Geoffrey Watling Way to its junction with Kerrison Road to facilitate stage building works from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Carrow Road, Canaryfields, Geoffrey Watling Way and vice versa.

**CECIL ROAD -** from its junction with Ipswich Road for 30m westwards to facilitate UK Power Networks link-box replacement works between 08:00 on 29<sup>th</sup> May and 17:00 on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road, Hall Road, Cecil Road.

**HALL ROAD** - from its junction with Mansfield Lane to its junction with St. Johns Close to facilitate carriageway patching works between 09:00 and 16:00 from 29<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. NB. The closure will only be in place for one day between the above dates. Alternative route is via: Hall Road, Barrett Road, Mansfield Lane and vice versa.

**JAMIESON PLACE 1 -** footpath Norwich 4F506 from its junction with Jamieson Place to its junction with Knowland Grove to facilitate fibre installation works from 30<sup>th</sup> May to 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Knowland Grove, Jamieson Place Footpath to Knowland Grove, Jamieson Place and vice versa.

MARKET AVENUE AND FARMERS AVENUE - 1) Market Avenue into Castle Meadow; and 2) Farmers Avenue from its junction with Castle Meadow for 30m southwards to facilitate tree care works.

The road 1) will be temporarily subject to a no left turn restriction; and 2) will be subject to the temporary suspension of the pedestrianised zone between 08:00 and 16:00 on 28<sup>th</sup> May 2023. Alternative route is via: 1) Rose Lane, Cattle Market Street and Farmers Avenue; and 2) N/A. **NB. The suspension of the pedestrianised zone on Farmers Avenue is to accommodate the diversion route for Market Avenue.** 

**QUEBEC ROAD** - from its junction with Kett's Hill for 20m southwards to facilitate water cover maintenance works from 30<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Kett's Hill, Britannia Road, Wolfe Road, Quebec Road and vice versa.

**SCARNELL ROAD -** from its junction with Cunningham Road for 50m southwards to facilitate new electrical connection works from 30<sup>th</sup> May to 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Cunningham Road, Friends Road and vice versa.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
