## Norfolk County Council TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH) Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**CAVELL ROAD** - from 16m east of its junction with Mansfield Lane for 16m eastwards to facilitate carriageway maintenance works from 29<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Mansfield Lane, Barrett Road, Long John Hill, Cavell Road and vice versa.

**GIPSY LANE** - cycle path from its junction with Farrow Road to its junction with Gipsy Lane to facilitate telecommunication works between 08:00 and 18:00 from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> June 2023; and 31<sup>st</sup> July to 3<sup>rd</sup> August, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. Alternative route is N/A. Cyclists will be asked to dismount and use the footway.

**KING STREET - 1) King Street cycle path** from its junction with the Novi Sad Bridge to its junction with King Street; and **2) footpath Norwich 4Y82** from its junction with the Novi Sad Bridge for 40m northwards to facilitate private development works from 29<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> December 2023. Alternative route is via: 1) cyclists to dismount and use alternative route provided, as signed on site; and 2) alternative footway to be available, as signed on site.

**NEW MILLS YARD** - from its junction with Oak Street to its junction with The Moorings to facilitate Virgin Media customer connection works between 08:00 and 18:00 from 26<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: The Moorings, Unicorn Yard, Oak Street and vice versa.

**QUEENS ROAD -** from its junction with St Stephens Street roundabout for 350m south-eastwards to facilitate reclamite spreading works between 06:00 and 13:00 on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Queens Road, Bracondale, Martineau Lane, Barrett Road, Lakenham Road, Ipswich Road, St Stephens Road and vice versa. *NB. Alternative route for Brazengate - All Saints Green and Surrey Street. Brazengate to All Saints Green route will remain open.* 

**RIVERSIDE ROAD** - from its junction with Thorpe Road to its junction with Bishop Bridge Road to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works between 19:00 on 30<sup>th</sup> June and 06:00 on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2023. Alternative route is via: Bishop Bridge Road, Ketts Hill, Plumstead Road, Harvey Lane, Thorpe Road, Carrow Road, Canary Way, Koblenz Avenue, Riverside and vice versa.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**CARROW ROAD -** from 12m northeast of its junction with King Street for 70m north-eastwards to facilitate bridge maintenance and repair works between 19:00 and 05:00 from 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023; and 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> July 2023 (back-up dates). Alternative route is via: Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Barrack Street, St Crispins Road, Barn Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, Queens Road, Bracondale, King Street and vice versa.

**JAMIESON PLACE 3 -** footpath Norwich 4F503 from its junction with Jamieson Place to its junction with Knowland Grove to facilitate fibre installation works from 13<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternative route is via: Jamieson Place, Jamieson Place Footpath, Knowland Grove, Jamieson Place Footpath, Knowland Grove and vice versa.

RUPERT STREET, NORFOLK STREET, ESSEX STREET AND TRINITY STREET - 1) Rupert Street from its junction with Norfolk Street to its junction with Essex Street (both sides of the carriageway); 2) Norfolk Street from 15m east of its junction with Rupert Street for 30m eastwards

(south side of the carriageway only); **3) Essex Street** from its junction with Rupert Street to its junction with Suffolk Square (both sides of the carriageway); and **4) Norwich 4Y79 footpath/cycle path** from its junction with Trinity Street to its junction with Rupert Street to facilitate footway resurfacing scheme works. The roads 1), 2) and 3) will be subject to a temporary parking restriction and vehicles will not be permitted to stop, load or unload; and the footpath 4) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 12<sup>th</sup> June to 28<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Alternative route is via: 1), 2) and 3) N/A; and 4) Rupert Street, Norfolk Street, Union Street, Cambridge Street, Trinity Street and vice versa.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
