TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH)
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

ABBOT ROAD - from its junction with Hall Road for 30m south-eastwards to facilitate UK Power Networks new connection works from 5th to 11th July 2023. Alternative route is via: Abbot Road, Randolph Road, Latimer Road, Hall Road and vice versa.

CHAPELFIELD EAST - loading bay for its entire length (approx. 29m) to facilitate alternative parking for construction vehicles as well as visitors to the nursery displaced by nearby works. Alternative route is N/A. The road will be subject to the temporary suspension of the loading/unloading restriction from 4th July 2023 to 31st January 2024.

KETTS HILL - 1) Ketts Hill from its junction with Gurney Road for 30m eastwards; and **2) Gurney Road** from its junction with Heathgate to its junction with Ketts Hill roundabout to facilitate Ketts Hill roundabout reconfiguration works from 3rd July to 11th August 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. Alternative route is via: 1) Gurney Road, Mousehold Lane, Sprowston Road, Magdalen Road, Bull Close Road, Charlton Road, Barrack Street and vice versa; and 2) Ketts Hill, Plumstead Road, Heartsease Lane, Mousehold Lane Sprowston Road, Magdalen Road, Bull Close Road, Charlton Road, Barrack Street and vice versa. Alternative route will change to Gurney Road, Heartsease Lane, Plumstead Road, Ketts Hill.

KNOWLAND GROVE FOOTPATH - footpath Norwich 4F496 from its junction with Knowland Grove for 85m north-eastwards to facilitate fibre installation works from 4th to 17th July 2023. Alternative route is via: Woodhill Rise, Woodhill Rise Footpath to Knowland Grove and vice versa.

KNOWLAND GROVE FOOTPATH 2 - footpath Norwich 4F494 from its junction with Knowland Grove for 91m north-eastwards to facilitate telecoms installation works from 4th to 17th July 2023. Alternative route is via: Knowland Grove Footpath to Woodhill Rise, Woodhill Rise, Knowland Grove and vice versa.

MAYFLY WAY SCHEME - 1) Barnard Road from its junction with Robberds Way for 100m westwards; **2) Chapel Break Road** from 70m northeast of its junction with Mayfly Way for 70m south-westwards; **3) Harpsfield** from its junction with Thurlby Road for 30m westwards; **4) Mayfly Way footpath** from its junction with Harpsfield for 210m northwards; **5) Mayfly Way footpath** from 50m north of its junction with Chapel Break Road to its junction with Barnard Road; **6) Mayfly Way footpath** from its junction with Barnard Road for 50m northwards; to facilitate Mayfly Way Scheme carriageway and resurfacing works from 1) 24th July to 8th September 2023; 2) 3rd July 2023 to 11th August 2023; 3) 3rd July to 11th August 2023; 4) 3rd July to 8th September 2023; 5) 24th July to 15th September 2023; 6) 14th August to 29th September 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. *NB. roads 2) and 3) will not be closed at the same time without the period given.* Alternative route is via: 1) N/A - access maintained at all time; 2) Chapel Break Road, Harpsfield, Astley Road and vice versa; 3) Harpsfield, Astley Road, Chapel Break Road and vice versa; 4) Mayfly Way, Peck Close, Atkinson Close and vice versa; 5) Chapel Break Road, Barnard Road and vice versa; and 6) Barnard Road, Francis Way and vice versa.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

BANK STREET - from its junction with Upper King Street to its junction with Bank Plain to facilitate shop glass replacement works between 07:00 and 18:00 on 18th June 2023. Alternative route is via:

Upper King Street, Prince of Wales Road, St Vedast Street, Rose Lane, Market Avenue and Bank Plain.

BARRACK STREET AND BARGATE COURT - 1) Barrack Street into Bargate Court; and **2) Bargate Court** into Barrack Street; to facilitate power cable installation works. The roads 1) and 2) will be temporarily subject to a no right turn restriction from 19th to 23rd June 2023. Alternative route is via: 1) Barrack Street, Barrack Street/St Crispins Road Roundabout, Barrack Street and Bargate Court; and 2) Bargate Court, Barrack Street, Barrack Street/Ketts Hill Roundabout and Barrack Street.

BARRET ROAD - (westbound only) from 100m east of its junction with Hall Road Roundabout to its junction with Hall Road Roundabout to facilitate telecommunication works between 19:00 and 05:00 from 20th to 23rd June 2023. Alternative route is via: Barrett Road, Martineau Lane, Loddon Road, Southern Bypass, A47 J A146 Join W, A47 Through J A146 W, A47 From J A146 To J A140 W, Norwich Southern Bypass, A47 Through J A140 W, A47 J A140 Leave W, Ipswich Road Southern Bypass Roundabout, Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road (Caistor St. Edmund and Bixley, Trowse with Newton, Keswick and Intwood).

CANARY WAY - from its junction with Koblenz Avenue for 10m eastwards to facilitate Traffic Signals Replacement works between 19:00 and 06:00 from 19th to 21st June 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. Alternative route is via: Westbound – Canary Way, Carrow Road, Clarence Road, Thorpe Road, Harvey Lane, Plumstead Road, Ketts Hill, Bishop Bridge Road, Riverside Road, Riverside and Koblenz Avenue. Eastbound - Koblenz Avenue, Riverside, Riverside Road, Bishop Bridge Road, Ketts Hill Roundabout, Bishop Bridge Road, Riverside Road, Thorpe Road, Carrow Road and Canary Way.

JAMIESON PLACE 4 - footpath Norwich 4F504 from its junction with Jamieson Place to its junction with Knowland Grove to facilitate fibre installation works from 21st to 28th June 2023. The closure will be clearly indicated on site. Alternative route is via: Jamieson Place, Knowland Grove and vice versa.

MELROSE ROAD - from its junction with Mile End Road for 50m south-westwards to facilitate Openreach overhead cable works between 09:30 and 15:30 on 20th June 2023. Alternative route is via: Melrose Road, Upton Road, Newmarket Road, Mile End Road.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
