NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the Wilberforce Road from its junction with Rockingham Road for 40m southwards in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate gas escape repair works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 13th June 2023 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 20th to 26th June 2023 (previously 13th to 19th June 2023) for the duration of the works expected to be about 7 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Rockingham Road, Earlham West Centre, Hutchinson Road, Earlham Green Lane, Earlham Road, Wilberforce Road and vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
