## Norfolk County Council TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH) Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**BARRETT ROAD -** (westbound flow only) from its junction with Hall Road Roundabout for 40m eastwards to facilitate power cable installation works between 19:00 and 06:00 from 24<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Alternative route is via: Barrett Road, Martineau Lane, Bracondale, Queens Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Ipswich Road and Lakenham Road.

**SALTER AVENUE** - footpath Norwich 4F535 from its junction with Salter Avenue to its junction with Jasmine Close to facilitate gas main works from 24<sup>th</sup> July to 4<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Salter Avenue, Primula Drive, Jasmine Close and vice versa.

**WHEATLEY ROAD -** from its junction with Waterman Road for 30m northwards to facilitate telecoms installation works from 28<sup>th</sup> July to 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Wheatley Road, Waterman Road and vice versa.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

BOUNDARY JUNCTION SCHEME - 1) Mile Cross Lane into Reepham Road; 2) Reepham Road (southbound only) from its junction with Merchant Way to its junction with Cromer Road; 3) Cromer Road from its junction with Mayfield Avenue to its junction with Mile Cross Lane; 4) Aylsham Road from its junction with Mile Cross Lane to its junction with Bollingbroke Road; 5) Boundary Road into Reepham Road; 6) Vera Road from its junction with Boundary Road for 10m northwards; and 7) Boundary Road/Mile Cross Lane from its junction with Overbury Road for 775m eastwards to facilitate traffic signal upgrade and carriageway resurfacing works. The road(s) 1) will be temporarily subject to a no right turn restriction from 10<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023; 2), 3) and 4) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 10<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023; 5) will be temporarily subject to a no left turn restriction from 7<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> August 2023, and between 19:00 and 07:00 from 15<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> August 2023; 6) will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 10th to 18th August 2023; and 7) will be temporarily subject to a 20mph speed restriction from 10<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. Alternative route is via: 1) Mile Cross Lane, Boundary Road, Sweet Briar Road, Dereham Road/Sweet Briar Road roundabout, Sweet Briar Road, Boundary Road and Reepham Road. NB. from 7th to 11th August 2023; and 15th to 20th August 2023 (between 19:00 and 07:00) the diversion will be amended to Mile Cross Lane, Boundary Road, Sweet Briar Road, Dereham Road/Sweet Briar Road roundabout, Sweet Briar Road, Boundary Road, Mile Cross Lane, Chartwell Road, Sprowston Road, Wroxham Road, Broadland Northway, Holt Road and Cromer Road; 2) Cromer Road - Reepham Road, Middleton's Lane and Cromer Road; Boundary Junction - Reepham Road, Middleton's Lane, Cromer Road, Broadland Northway, Wroxham Road, Sprowston Road, Chartwell Road and Mile Cross Lane; 3) Cromer Road, Holt Road, Broadland Northway, Wroxham Road, Sprowston Road, Chartwell Road and Mile Cross Lane; 4) Northbound traffic on Aylsham Road and Westbound traffic on Mile Cross Lane - Boundary Road, Drayton Road, Mile Cross Road, Aylsham Road and vice versa; eastbound traffic on Boundary Road - Boundary Road, Mile Cross Lane, Chartwell Road, Chartwell Road/Constitution Hill roundabout, Chartwell Road, Mile Cross Lane, Boundary Road, Drayton Road, Mile Cross Road and Aylsham Road; 5) Mile Cross Lane, Chartwell Road, Sprowston Road, Wroxham Road, Broadland Northway, Holt Road and Cromer Road; 6) Alternative northbound route - Boundary Road, Reepham Road, Merchants Way and Vera Road;

Southbound route – Reepham Road, Middleton's Lane, Drayton High Road and Boundary Road; Northbound route when restriction 5) is in place heading westbound on Boundary Road – Boundary Road, Drayton High Road, Middleton's Lane, Reepham Road and vice vera; Northbound route when restriction 5) is in place heading eastbound on Boundary Road –Boundary Road, Mile Cross Lane, Chartwell Road, Chartwell Road/Constitution Hill Roundabout, Chartwell Road, Mile Cross Lane, Boundary Road, Drayton High Road, Middleton's Lane, and Reepham Road; Southbound route when restriction 5) is in place – Reepham Road, Middleton's Lane, Drayton High Road and Boundary Road; and 7) N/A. NB. All diversion routes will be clearly indicated on site for the duration of the works.

**DANIELS ROAD and IPSWICH ROAD - 1) Daniels Road** from its junction with Newmarket Road Roundabout to its junction with Ipswich Road; and **2) Ipswich Road** from its junction with Daniels Road to its junction with St Stephens Road to facilitate surface dressing works (i) on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2023; (ii) on 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2023 (reserve dates); (iii) between 19:00 and 06:00 from 18<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2023; and (iv) between 19:00 and 06:00 from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> August 2023 (reserve dates), only while signs indicating the closure are in place. *NB. the two roads will not be closed at the same time.* Alternative route is via: 1) Ipswich Road, St Stephens Road, St Stephens Road roundabout, St Stephens Road and vice versa; and 2) Daniels Road, Newmarket Road roundabout, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
