

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the Beverley Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 30m northwards in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate gas escape repair works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 10th July 2023 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 15th to 21st July 2023 (previously 11th to 14th July 2023) for the duration of the works expected to be about 7 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Earlham Road, Gipsy Lane, Beverley Road and vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
