## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Clarke Road and Knowsley Road) (Emergency Continuation Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

## Notice (CTRO)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to gas escape the use by vehicles of the:

- 1) Clarke Road from its junction with Magdalen Road for 50m westwards; and
- 2) Knowsley Road from its junction with Magdalen Road for 50m eastwards;

in the CITY OF NORWICH will continue to be temporarily prohibited from 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> July 2023 (previously 10<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> 2023) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 9 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

## Alternative route is via:

- 1) Guernsey Road, Heath Road, Clarke Road and vice versa.
- 2) Beaconsfield Road, Spencer Street, Knowsley Road and vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
