Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Mile End Road) (Emergency Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency gas works the use by vehicles of the Mile End Road from its junction with Newmarket Road for 20m westwards (westbound only) in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 31st July to 7th August 2023 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 8 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Alternative route is via: Mile End Road, Colman Road, Farrow Road, Guardian Road, Dereham Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
