NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the 1) Daniels Road from its junction with Newmarket Road Roundabout to its junction with Ipswich Road; and 2) Ipswich Road from its junction with Daniels Road to its junction with St Stephens Road in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate surface dressing works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 6th July 2023 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 8th to 13th August 2023 (previously 9th July to 7th August 2023) for the duration of the works expected to be about 6 days within the period, only while signs indicating the closure are in place.

Alternative route is via: 1) Ipswich Road, St Stephens Road, St Stephens Road roundabout, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road and vice versa; and 2) Daniels Road, Newmarket Road roundabout, Newmarket Road and vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
