**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH)**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

**(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**GIPSY LANE** - Gipsy Lane cycle path from its junction with Farrow Road for 20m north-westwards to facilitate telecommunication works between 08:00 and 17:00 on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is N/A. Cyclists will be asked to dismount and use the footpath.

**GLOUCESTER STREET** - from 15m northwest of its junction with Rupert Street for 15m south-eastwards to facilitate defective reinstatement replacement works from 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Gloucester Street, Durham Street, Onley Street, Leicester Street and vice versa. Alternative route for Rupert Street: Rupert Street, York Street, Leicester Street and Gloucester Street.

**SILVER ROAD** - from its junction with Barrack Street for 20m northwards to facilitate gas connection works on 27<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Silver Road, Sprowston Road, Magdalen Road, Bull Close Road, Charlton Road, Barrack Street and vice versa.

**TRINITY STREET, CAMBRIDGE STREET AND RUPERT STREET - 1) Trinity Street** from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Rupert Street; **2) Rupert Street** from its junction with Trinity Street to its junction with Cambridge Street; and **3) Cambridge Street** from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Rupert Street to facilitate essential utility works. NB. Road 1) will be closed in 50m phases to ensure minimum disruption. Emergency access will be maintained at all times. The road 1) will be temporarily closed (except for access) and will also be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (westbound); the road 2) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (northbound); and 3) will be temporarily subject to a suspension of the one-way restriction (eastbound) from 28<sup>th</sup> August to 25<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Alternative route is via: Rupert Street, Cambridge Street, Unthank Road and vice versa.

**WILBERFORCE ROAD** - from its junction with Bridge Farm Road for 70m south-eastwards to facilitate communications upgrade and maintenance works between 08:00 and 16:30 from 29<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Wilberforce Road, Earlham Road, Earlham Green Lane, Malbrook Road, Wiberforce Road, vice versa.

**(ii) THEY HAVE MADE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**CHALK HILL ROAD** - from its junction with Riverside Road for 30m eastwards to facilitate UK Power Networks electrical installation works from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Chalk Hill Road, Rosary Road, St Matthews Road, Riverside Road and vice versa.

**COLMAN ROAD** - from its junction with Earlham Road Roundabout for 10m southwards to facilitate telecom chamber works between 19:00 and 23:00 from 24<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Earlham Road, Unthank Road, Convent Road, Grapes Hill, Chapel Field Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Newmarket Road, Mile End Road and Colman Road.

**GEORGE BORROW ROAD & HODGSON ROAD (PHASE 3) – 1) George Borrow Road** from its junction with Hodgson Road for 40m southwards; and **2) Hodgson Road** from its junction with George Borrow Road for 20m north-eastwards to facilitate gas main replacement scheme works from 21<sup>st</sup>

August to 1<sup>st</sup> September 2023. Alternative route is via: George Borrow Road, Earlham Road, Henderson Road and vice versa.

**JUDGES WALK** - from its junction with A11 Newmarket Road for 50m northwards to facilitate electrical installation works from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Alternative route is via: Newmarket Road, Unthank Road, Judges Walk and vice versa.

**ST. FAITHS LANE SCHEME - 1) St. Faiths Lane** from its junction with Prince of Wales Road for 20m northwards; and **2) Prince of Wales Road** (northside of the carriageway only) from 25m west of its junction with St. Faiths Lane for 17m westwards to facilitate long-term development construction hoarding works. The road 1) will be temporarily closed (except for access); and traffic using the road 2) will be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles from 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2023 to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024 for the duration of the works. Alternative route is via: 1) Cathedral Street, St Faiths Lane and vice versa; and 2) N/A.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
