NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the Wilberforce Road from its junction with Bridge Farm Road for 70m south-eastwards in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate communications upgrade and maintenance works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 25th August 2023 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect between 08:00 and 16:30 on 1st September 2023 (previously between 08:00 and 16:30 from 29th to 31st August 2023) for the duration of the works expected to be about 9 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: Wilberforce Road, Earlham Road, Earlham Green Lane, Malbrook Road, Wiberforce Road, vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
