

Norfolk County Council (Norwich, South Park Avenue)
(Emergency Notice)
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2023
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to an emergency gas escape the use by vehicles of South Park Avenue from its junction with Colman Road for 60m westwards in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 6th to 10th September 2023 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 5 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

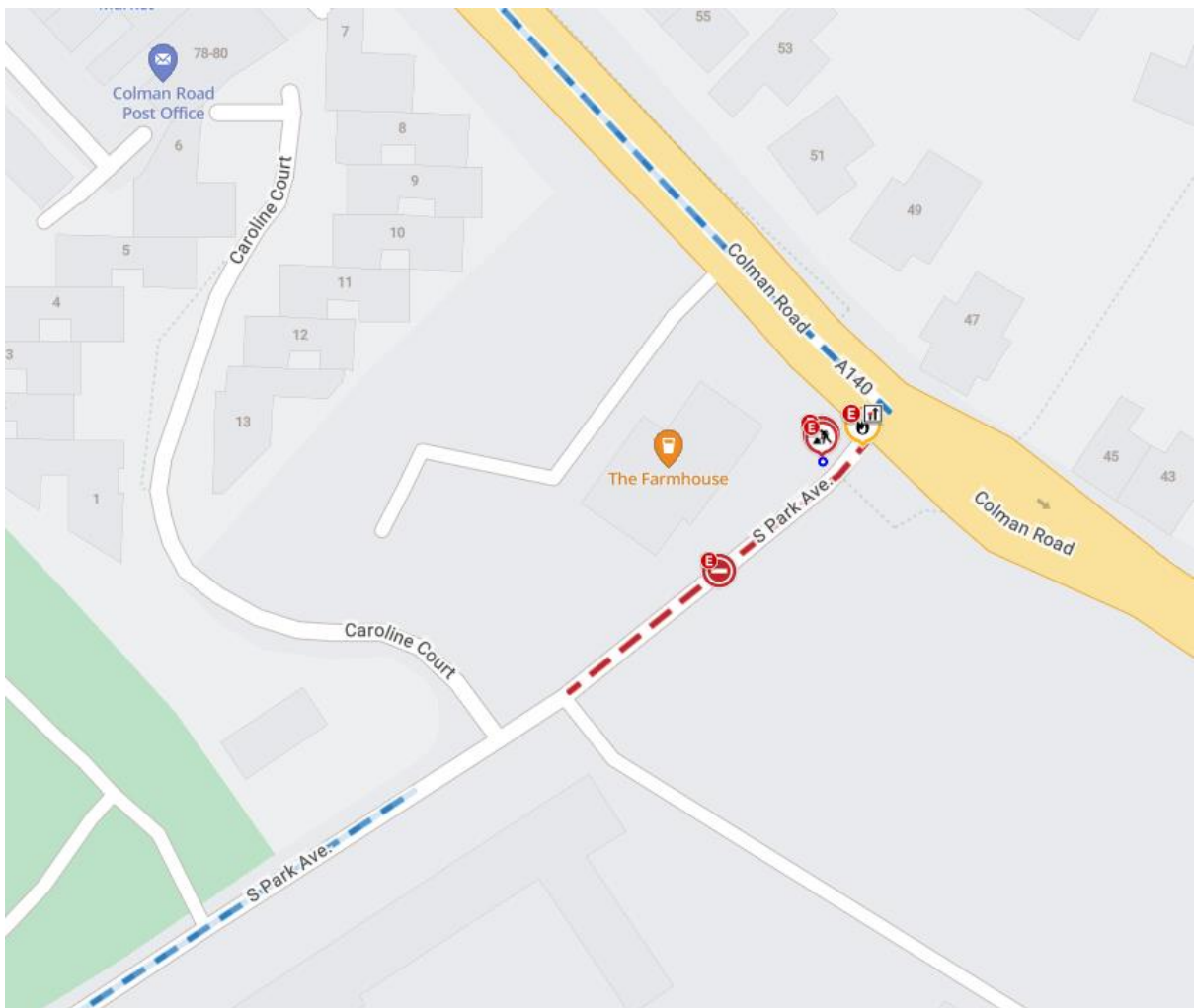
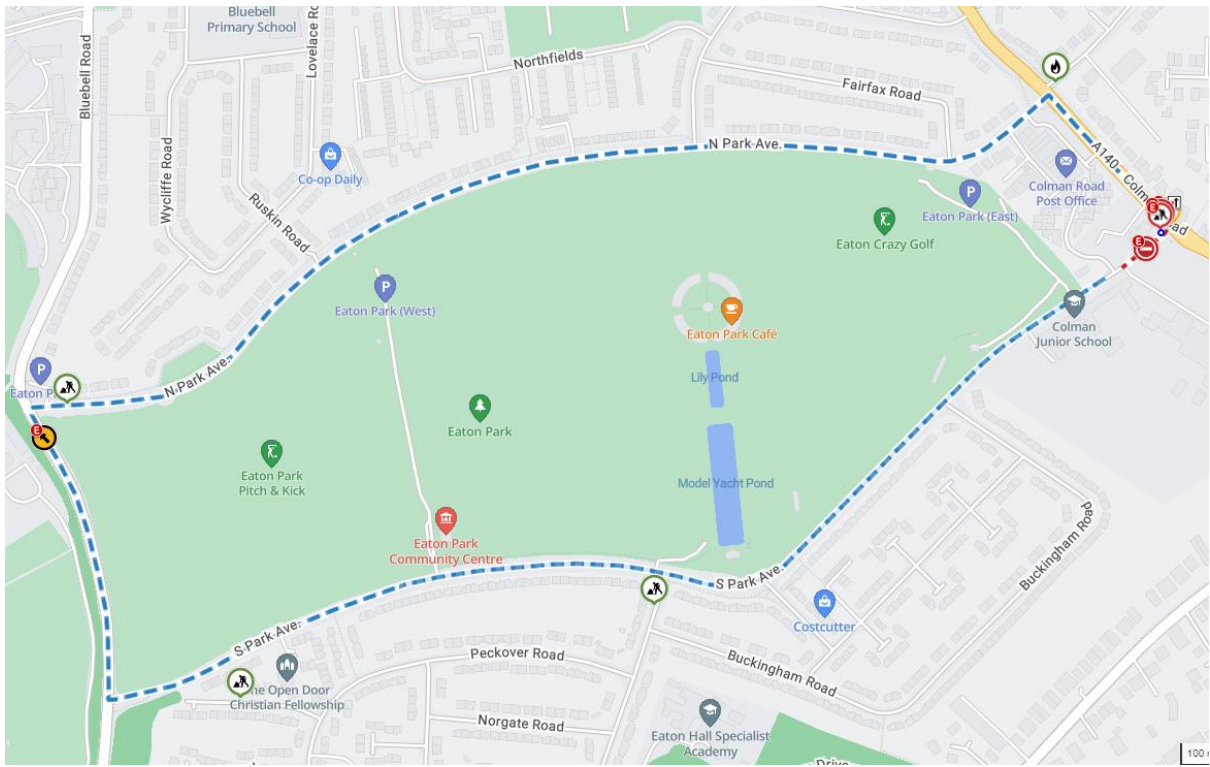
Alternative route is via: Colman Road, North Park Avenue, Bluebell Road, South Park Avenue and vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
