

**Norfolk County Council**  
**TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH)**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984**

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

**(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**GUARDIAN ROAD, FARROW ROAD and BOWTHORPE ROAD - 1) Guardian Road** from its junction with Bowthorpe Road for 150m northwards; **2) Farrow Road** from its junction with Bowthorpe Road to its junction with Earlham Road Roundabout; and **3) Bowthorpe Road** from its junction with Farrow Road for 60m south-westwards to facilitate Norfolk County Council resurfacing works. The roads 1), 2) & 3) will be temporarily closed (except for access); and traffic using the road 3) will be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> September; and 7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Alternative route is via: 1) & 2) Earlham Road, Watton Road, A47, Dereham Road and vice versa; and 3) Bowthorpe Road, Gipsy Lane, Earlham Road, Unthank Road, Convent Road, Grapes Hill, Dereham Road and Bowthorpe Road.

**STANLEY AVENUE** - from 125m north of its junction with Thorpe Road for 20m eastwards to facilitate new water connection works from 27<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Alternative route is via: Stanley Avenue, Thorpe Road, Harvey Lane and vice versa.

**TIZZICK CLOSE** - from 110m southwest of its junction with Bladewater Road for 30m southwards to facilitate fibre network installation works from 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. Alternative route is via: Tizzick Close.

**(ii) THEY HAVE MADE** Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

**CAMBRIDGE STREET** - from its junction with Unthank Road to its junction with Rupert Street to facilitate lead communication pipe replacement works from 18<sup>th</sup> September to 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Alternative route is via: Unthank Road, Essex Street, Vauxhall Street, Norfolk Street, Union Street, Cambridge Street.

**REDWELL STREET** - onto St Andrews to facilitate electrical connection works. The road will be temporarily subject to a no right turn restriction from 18<sup>th</sup> September to 27<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Alternative route is via: Bank Plain, Agricultural Hall Plain, Prince of Wales Road, St Vedast Street, Rose Lane, Market Avenue, Agricultural Hall Plain, Bank Plain and St Andrews Street.

**WIBERFORCE ROAD** - from its junction with Bridge Farm Road for 70m south-eastwards to facilitate communications upgrade and maintenance works between 08:00 and 16:30 on 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023. **Please note that these dates replace any previously advertised dates in respect of this location.** Alternative route is via: Wilberforce Road, Earlham Road, Earlham Green Lane, Malbrook Road, Wiberforce Road, vice versa.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
