Norfolk County Council TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS 2023 (NORWICH) Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984

Norfolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby give notice that:

(i) THEY PROPOSE TO MAKE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

HILARY AVENUE - from its junction with Lloyd Road to its junction with Samuel Road to facilitate utility cover repair works between 07:00 and 18:00 on 23rd November 2023. Alternative route is via: Hilary Avenue, Plumstead Road, Ketts Hill, Gurney Road, Heartsease Lane, Borrowdale Drive and vice versa.

RUTLAND STREET - from its junction with York Street to its junction with Gloucester Street to facilitate water pipe replacement works. The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and traffic using the road will be temporarily prohibited from parking, stopping and loading/unloading vehicles (including resident parking) from 20th November to 1st December 2023. Alternative route is via: York Street, Unthank Road, Gloucester Street and vice versa.

ST CLEMENTS HILL - from its junction with Elm Grove Lane for 50m southwards to facilitate telecoms mast installation works between 20:00 and 05:00 from 20th to 22nd November 2023. Alternative route is via: Woodcock Road, Catton Grove Road, Elm Grove Lane, St Clements Hill and vice versa.

(ii) THEY HAVE MADE Temporary Traffic Regulation Orders in respect of the following roads:

ANGEL ROAD - from its junction with Millers Lane for 35m northwards to facilitate manhole repair works between 09:30 and 14:30 on 14th November 2023. Alternative route is via: Angel Road, Waterloo Road, Magdalen Road, Constitution Hill, Wall Road, Woodcock Road, Catton Grove Road and vice versa.

BARRETT ROAD - (westbound only) from its junction with Hall Road for 76m eastwards to facilitate communication works between 20:00 and 05:00 from i) 15th to 16th November 2023; and ii) 21st to 22nd November 2023. Alternative route is via: Barrett Road, Martineau Lane, Bracondale, Queens Road, St Stephens Roundabout, St Stephens Road, Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road. Additional Diversion route - Barrett Road, Martineau Lane, A146 Loddon Road, A47 Norwich Southern Bybass, A140 Ipswich Road, Lakenham Road.

GERTRUDE ROAD - from 40m east of its junction with Violet Road for 20m eastwards to facilitate gas connection works from 13th to 17th November 2023. Alternative route is via: Mousehold Avenue, Silver Road, Sprowston Road.

TURNER ROAD - from its junction with Dereham Road for 30m northwards to facilitate UK Power Networks electrical works between 08:30 and 18:00 from 15th to 16th November 2023, only while signs indicating the closure are in place. Alternative route is via: Dereham Road.

Unless otherwise stated, the effect of these Orders will be to prohibit the use by vehicles of the named road(s). All other restrictions are included where necessary. In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance. Alternative routes are shown where applicable and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If necessary, the restrictions could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Orders or 6 months in respect of footpaths, cycle paths, bridleways, restricted byways, and byways open to all traffic (BOAT).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
