## Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Lower Clarence Road) (Emergency Notice) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024 Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst main split collar repairs the use by vehicles of the Lower Clarence Road from its junction with Thorpe Road for 50m southwards in the CITY OF NORWICH will be temporarily prohibited from 25<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period.

This Notice has a maximum duration of 21 days. Where exceptional circumstances are encountered during the performance of the works specified in this Notice, the operational period of this Notice may become extended by issuing an Order or further Notice to allow completion of the works for a maximum duration of 18 months.

Alternative route is via: Alternative southbound route – Thorpe Road, Carrow Road, Clarence Road and Lower Clarence Road Alternative northound route - Lower Clarence Road, Clarence Road and Thorpe Road.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
