

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (CTRO867) affecting The Ridgeway from its junction with Gerald Close to its junction with Steepgreen Close in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate repairs of a burst water main.

This Order continues the provisions of the Notice dated 25th January 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect on the 9th February 2024 (previously 25th January to 8th February 2024) for the duration of the works, expected to be about 1 day within the period.

Alternative route is via: The Ridgeway, Borrowdale Drive and vice versa.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
