

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order affecting the Mount Pleasant from its junction with Unthank Road for 30m eastwards in the CITY OF NORWICH to facilitate Anglian Water new connection works.

This Order continues the provisions of the Order dated 16th February 2024 that the road will be temporarily closed (except for access) and the restriction will now continue in effect from 22nd to 23rd February 2024 (previously 19th February to 21st February 2024) for the duration of the works expected to be about 2 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Mount Pleasant, Newmarket Street, Bury Street, Unthank Road.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

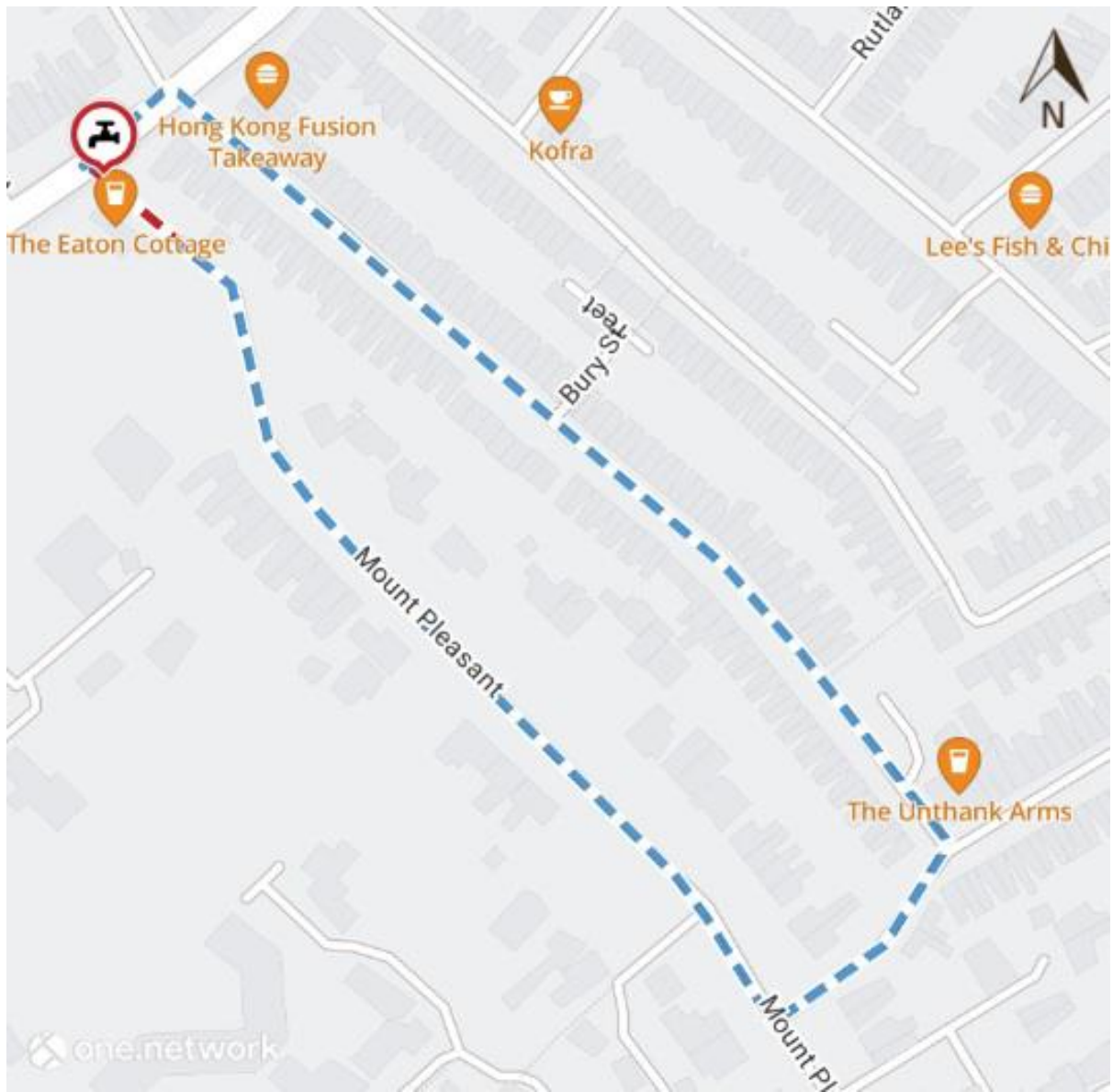
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
