

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Heigham Road and Mill Hill Road)**

**Urgent Notice**

**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024**

**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Norwich, Heigham Road and Mill Hill Road (CTRO1018) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to carriageway repairs on Earlham Road the use by vehicles (of any class/specific class) of the Heigham Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 15m northwards (the "Road A") and Mill Hill Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 15m southwards (the "Road B") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Roads A and B.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 29<sup>th</sup> July to 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024.

This Notice shall be in effect from 29<sup>th</sup> July to 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Alternative route is via: 1) Earlham Road, Unthank Road, Convent Road, Grapes Hill, Dereham Road, Heigham Road and vice versa. 2) Earlham Road, Park Lane, Mill Hill Road and vice versa.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


