Temporary Restriction of Traffic Movement

Norfolk County Council, HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that to facilitate the Corton House Summer Fete event, they intend to make a Traffic Order, the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend the existing parking restrictions on roads contained in the Zone Y in The Norwich City Council City Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation) TRO 2003 (as amended) in the CITY OF NORWICH.

The Order will come into effect on 31st August 2024 and will remain in force for 6 hours. The road will be temporarily restricted (except for emergency and pedestrian access) between 11:00 and 17:00 on the 31st August 2024 for the duration of the event. Restriction on traffic will only be enforced until normal traffic flow can be maintained.

Where appropriate during the period of the closure temporary suspension of existing permanent Traffic Orders may be imposed.

Alternative route will be via: N/A as roads remain open.


The promoter of the event is Imogen Bowers at Corton House Care Home.
