

**Norfolk County Council (Norwich, Silver Road and Bull Close)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

Silver Road and Bull Close (CTRO1077) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to emergency gas works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Silver Road from its junction with Wodehouse Street for 40m northwards (the "Road A") will be temporarily prohibited and; Bull Close Road onto Silver Road (the "Road B") shall be temporarily subject to a no right turn restriction for traffic manoeuvring onto Silver Road from Bull Close Road in the City of Norwich.

Alternative route is via: Northbound - Silver Road, Barrack Street, Barrack Street/Ketts Hill Roundabout, Barrack Street, Barrack Street/St Cripsins Road Roundabout, Charlton Road, Bull Close Road, Magdalen Road, and Sprowston Road. Southbound - Sprowston Road, Magdalen Road, Bull Close Road, Charlton Road, Barrack Street/St Cripsins Road Roundabout and Silver Road.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the roads A and B or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 16th to 23rd October 2024 but the Roads A and B may continue to be closed until the 5th November 2024 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 5th November 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
