

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (CTRO1344) affecting the Vulcan Road South from its junction with Mile Cross Lane to its junction with Concorde Lane ("Road A") and Vulcan Road North from 20m north of its junction with Burton Road for 50m southwards ("Road B") in the City of Norwich to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works, the Roads A and B will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be between 19:00 and 23:00 from 15<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> September 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

**NB: Please note that the restriction will take place for one evening (between 19:00 and 23:00) within the anticipated dates period.**

Alternative route is via: Vulcan Road North, Fifers Lane, Ives Road, St Faiths Road, Mile Cross Lane.

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
