Emergency Notice
Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025
Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Norwich, Heigham Road and Mill Hill Road (CTRO1391) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to gas escape repair works the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Heigham Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 45 metres northwards ("Road A") and Mill Hill Road from its junction with Earlham Road for 45 metres southwards ("Road B") in the City of Norwich will be temporarily prohibited/restricted.

Alternative route is via: **A)** Earlham Road, Guardian Road, Farrow Road, Dereham Road, Heigham Road and vice versa **B)** Park Lane, Unthank Road, Earlham Road and vice versa

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Cadent.

The closure/restriction is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place from 16th to 28th October 2025 but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 5th November 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 5th November 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

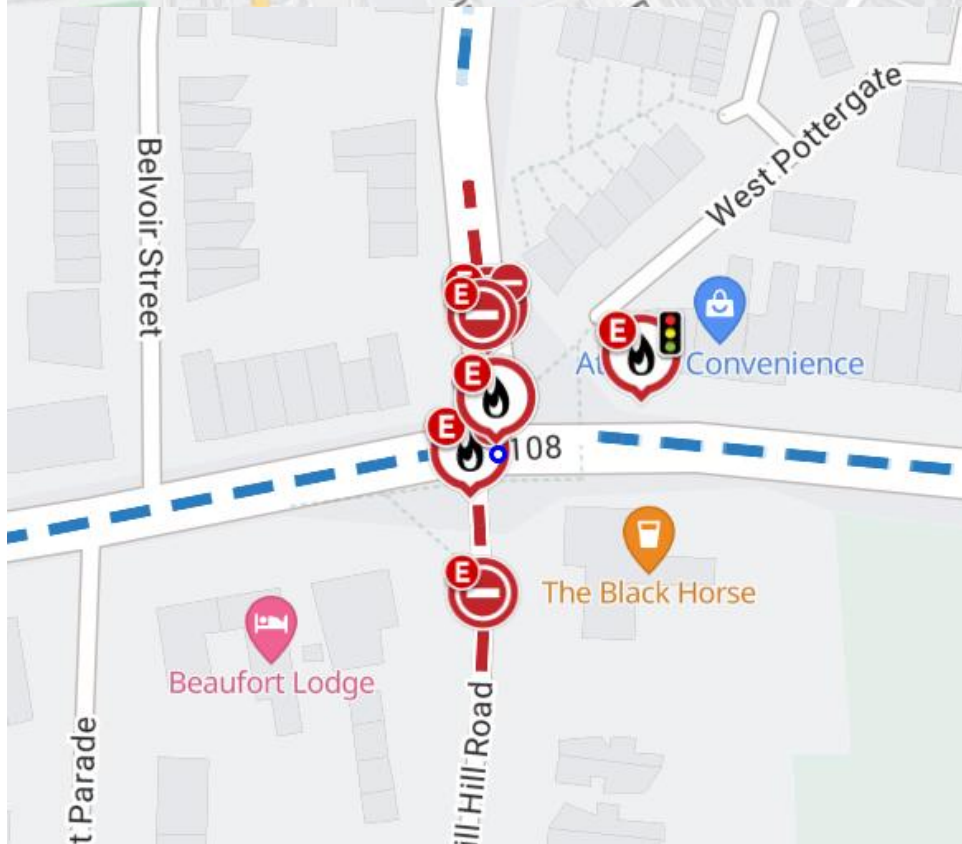
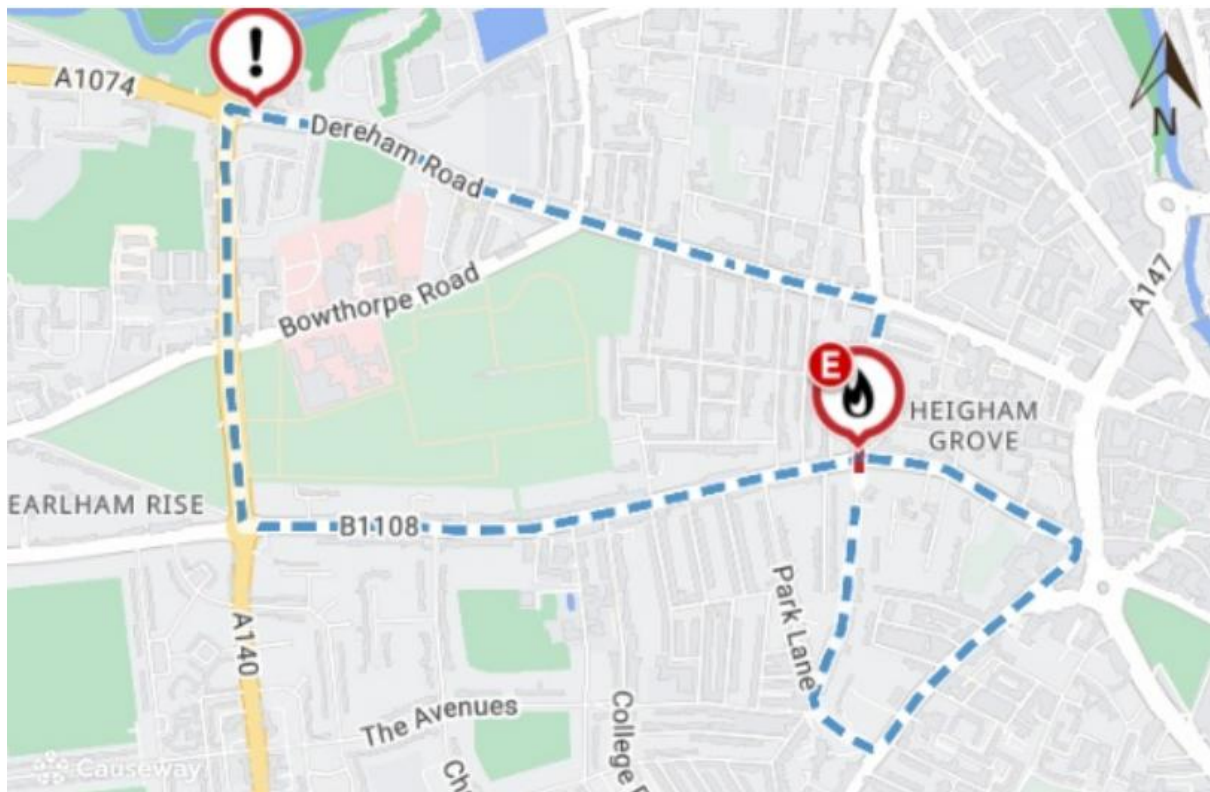
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
